From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

We are getting closer to our “Adore” week of Adoration, April 27th-May 2nd, and I am so excited. Can you believe that we are already over half way through our “33 Days to Eucharistic Glory Book?!” (If you’re behind, don’t worry at all, I’ll admit to getting a couple of days behind before catching up!) This means first communion is right around the corner as well: April 25th in Spanish and May 2nd in English.

In order for our “Adore” week of prayer to happen we need enough people to commit to an hour of prayer to cover each hour, 24 hours a day (with the exception of when the church is being used for Mass) for the duration of the event. This means that we need your help! In order to help facilitate even coverage throughout the week my proposal and hope is that for families who have school-aged students to make an effort to sign-up for particular days (but if the day I propose doesn’t work please feel free to sign-up for a different time that does work for you!). The goal of the whole thing is to get you in front of Jesus’ presence in the Eucharist so that you can receive, experience, and encounter His love!

In order to help fill all of the hours, ideally it would be helpful for parents from the following grades to sign-up for the following days and times:

Pre-school and Kindergarten:	Monday 8:30 am - Tuesday 6:30 am
First and Second Grade:	Tuesday 8:30 am - Wednesday 6:30 am
Third and Fourth Grade:	Wednesday 8:30 am - Thursday 6:30 am
Fifth and Sixth Grade:	Thursday 8:30 am - Friday 6:30 am
Seventh and Eighth Grade:	Friday 8:30 am - Saturday 6:30 am



For everyone else, feel free to sign-up wherever works for you, or wherever you see a gap in coverage. I will also say that the middle of the night hours often seem daunting, but so often, at the many parishes I have been at, people who adore our Lord during these vigil hours of the night report amazing peace and focus found in the silence and after trying it once stick with that hour when Adoration is made a regular and ongoing opportunity at the parish. So if you see those hours open I encourage you to give it a try!

You can sign-up by scanning the QR Code, going to ssppevents.com or clicking [here](#) and committing to one of the hour time slots found there. It is my hope that you will find this encounter with Jesus to be peaceful and transformative. In Psalm 41:10 God invites us to “BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD” and this is a perfect opportunity to do just that: Sign-up, Show up, Be Still, and Let God Love You!

As we draw closer I’ll continue to give more details and guidance, but know of my appreciation for your participation and I can’t wait to see how this transforms our parish and our community!
