As we prepare for our upcoming Adore event, taking place April 27th through May 2nd, we are filled with deep gratitude for the incredible response from our amazing parish community. Thank you to each and every person who has generously signed up to commit to an hour of Eucharistic Adoration. Your willingness to spend time in prayer before our Lord is a beautiful witness of faith and devotion, and it helps make this sacred time possible for all.

We are especially grateful for your commitment, which ensures that Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will never be left alone during these days of adoration. What a powerful gift to our parish and to one another.

If you have not yet signed up, there is still plenty of opportunity to do so! We warmly encourage you to visit ssppevents.com and choose an hour that works for you. Even if a time slot already has someone signed up, please feel free to add your name. Having multiple adorers during an hour is not only welcome but helpful, as it provides coverage in case someone is unexpectedly unable to attend.

It is also important to remember that everyone is welcome to come and spend time with Jesus at any point during the event. A filled time slot does not mean the chapel is reserved or exclusive, rather, the sign-up simply ensures that at least one person is present with our Lord. If you're not a scheduled adorer and you decide to pop-in, whether you decide to stay for a few minutes or a full hour, your presence in prayer is a blessing.

Finally, we ask you to keep our First Communicants in your prayers. These young members of our parish will receive Jesus in the Eucharist for the very first time on April 25th and May 2nd. May their hearts be filled with joy and wonder as they encounter Christ in this profound and personal way.

Thank you again for your faith, your generosity, and your love for the Eucharist. May this time of Adoration draw us all closer to the Heart of Jesus.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today, I am announcing a special campaign to identify young men in our diocese who, through God's providence, could have a vocation to the priesthood. The campaign, entitled *Called by Name*, will take place on April 25-26, 2026.

As you know, the Diocese of Rockford has a continuing need for "more workers for the harvest." I firmly believe that many of our future priests will come from our own parishes and schools, but we need the entire Church to identify them, so that we can accompany them as they discern their vocation.

I invite all Catholics to submit the names of young men that they would like to honor. Note that these men do not need to have expressed a desire to be priests. They simply need to love Christ and the Church, exhibit a strong faith, and have a heart for service.

I will send each of these young men a letter of congratulations and encouragement. In addition, our Vocation Team will offer support as they discern their vocations, especially by inviting them to summer discernment events.

This initiative is of living importance to the Church and to the faithful of Rockford, and I ask you to participate thoughtfully. Please join me in praying that the Lord will raise up many new shepherds for the Church.

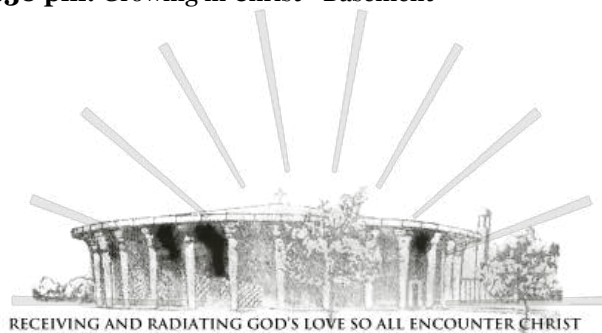

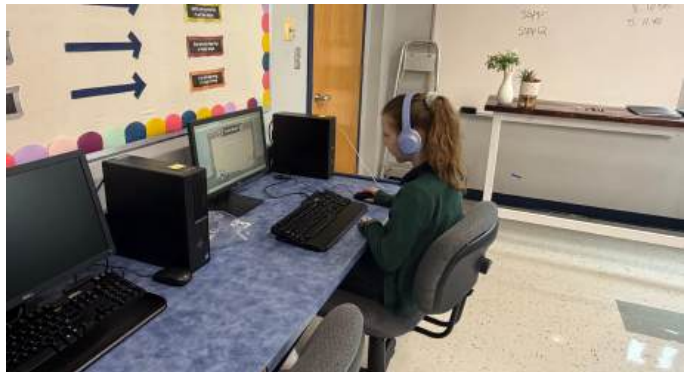

Queridísimos hermanos y hermanas:

Nos acercamos a nuestra semana de Adoración, titulada «Adore», que tendrá lugar del 27 de abril al 2 de mayo, ¡y estoy sumamente entusiasmado! ¿Pueden creer que ya hemos recorrido más de la mitad de nuestro libro «33 Días para la Gloria Eucarística»? (Si se han quedado atrás, no se preocupen en absoluto; ¡confieso que yo mismo me retrasé un par de días antes de ponerme al día!). Esto significa que la Primera Comunión también está a la vuelta de la esquina: el 25 de abril para el grupo de habla hispana y el 2 de mayo para el de habla inglesa.

Para que nuestra semana de oración «Adore» pueda llevarse a cabo, necesitamos que suficientes personas se comprometan a dedicar una hora de oración para cubrir cada una de las horas del día —las 24 horas— durante toda la duración del evento (con la excepción de los momentos en que la iglesia esté siendo utilizada para la Santa Misa). ¡Esto significa que necesitamos su ayuda! El objetivo de toda esta iniciativa es ponerlos ante la presencia de Jesús en la Eucaristía, ¡para que puedan recibir, experimentar y encontrarse con Su amor!

Siéntanse libres de inscribirse en el horario que mejor les convenga, aunque vean que ya está ocupado ese lugar, o en aquellos momentos en los que observen que hay un vacío en la cobertura. También quisiera mencionar que las horas de la madrugada a menudo pueden parecer intimidantes; sin embargo, en las muchas parroquias en las que he estado, las personas que adoran a nuestro Señor durante estas horas de vigilia nocturna suelen relatar que encuentran una paz y una concentración asombrosas en el silencio. De hecho, tras probarlo una sola vez, suelen comprometerse a mantener esa misma hora cuando la Adoración se establece como una oportunidad regular y continua en la parroquia. Por ello, si ven que esas horas están disponibles, ¡los animo a que lo intenten!

Es mi esperanza que este encuentro con Jesús resulte para ustedes una experiencia de paz y transformación. En el Salmo 41:10, Dios nos invita a: «ESTAR QUIETOS Y SABER QUE ÉL ES DIOS»; y esta es una oportunidad perfecta para hacer precisamente eso: ¡Inscríbanse, asistan, aquíetense y permitan que Dios los ame!

A medida que se acerque la fecha, seguiré compartiendo más detalles y orientaciones; pero, por lo pronto, sepan cuánto aprecio su participación. ¡Estoy deseando ver cómo esta iniciativa transforma nuestra parroquia y a nuestra comunidad!
