From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

At the Last Supper, Jesus begins with a striking expression of desire: “I have greatly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer” (Lk 22:15). Those words are not only about a meal. They reveal the heart of Christ who is longing to be in communion with His disciples, and ultimately with all of us. That same divine desire continues to echo through the Church’s life today in the Eucharist and in Eucharistic Adoration. When we gather at Mass, we are not recalling a distant historical event. We are being drawn into the very same mystery: the Last Supper, the Cross, and the Resurrection made present. The same Jesus who spoke those words of desire is the One who now says, in a very real sense: “I have greatly desired to share this Mass with you.” The Eucharist received at Mass today is not different from what was given in the Upper Room. It is the same Lord, the same self-offering love, made present through the mystery of consecration. Every Mass is therefore not simply a remembrance, but an encounter: Christ gives Himself again in the same sacramental way, inviting us into communion with Him.

At the consecration, when the priest speaks the words of Jesus: “This is My Body, given up for you” and he then elevates the sacred Host. That moment is deeply profound. Christ is lifted up, offered to the Father, and shown to the people as the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. It is a moment of silent awe: the same Jesus who desired to eat with His disciples is now truly present on the altar, given for us. Eucharistic Adoration which we will be having available all week can be understood as an extended participation in that elevation. What is briefly held aloft at Mass is what we then remain before in Adoration. The Host is no longer momentarily elevated and set down, rather, it is exposed so that we may linger in that same mystery: Christ present, offered, and loving us. In Adoration, time is not simply “extra devotion.” It is a prolonged gaze at what the Mass already makes present. It is as if the Church allows us to remain at the foot of the altar at the moment when Christ is lifted up so we can stay there, quietly, with Him. We could say that Adoration is the Church inviting us to remain in that moment of love when Jesus says, through the priest’s hands: “This is My Body given up for you.” And instead of quickly going off to do other things, we stay, receiving, adoring, listening, loving in return.

You all know that I myself, have greatly desired to share this week with you! And so I want to extend heartfelt gratitude to everyone who has already signed up to spend time in Adoration. Your “yes” matters more than it may seem because it helps ensure that Jesus is never left alone, and that our community continues to surround Him with love, prayer, and presence. At the same time, everyone is warmly invited: whether for a few minutes or a longer period, you are welcome to come and spend time with the Lord anytime between 8:30am and 9:00pm, while the doors remain open (with the exception of 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm on Wednesday and 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm on Thursday). There is no pressure, no expectation, only an open invitation to be with Jesus who has first desired to be with us. From the Upper Room, to the altar at Mass, to the quiet of Adoration, there is one continuous reality: Christ’s desire to be with His people. “I have greatly desired...” is not only spoken once in history. It is the living heart of the Eucharist. It is the reason the Church gathers, the reason the Host is elevated, and the reason we can sit in silence before Him in Adoration. Jesus still desires to be with us. And in the Eucharist, He is.

Have an amazing week, I hope you enjoy your time with Jesus, and please keep in your prayers our young disciples who received their First Communion on Saturday and those who will do so this upcoming Saturday!

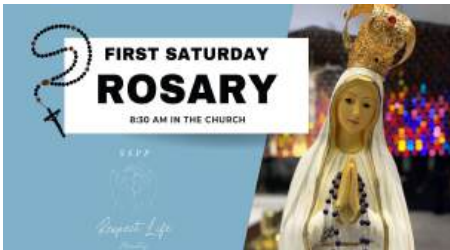

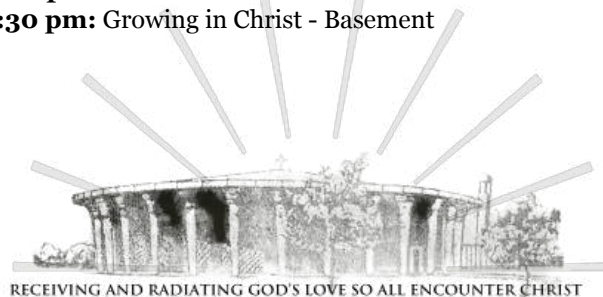

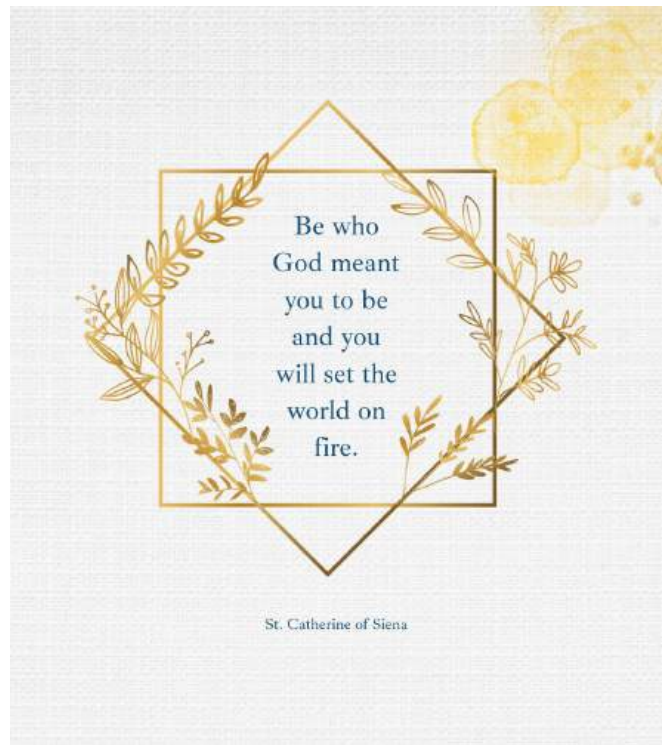
