From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

What a week! We had so many parishioners touched by the Heart of Our Lord during Adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist! It was so powerful and moving for me to stop into the church throughout the day each day and see so many people resting in the love of our Lord. Thank you for all of the scheduled adorers whose commitment made the entire week possible! In the same vein congratulations to all of our First Communicants who have united Jesus' Heart with their own in communion over the past 2 weekends.

It is with a grateful yet bittersweet heart to announce that Deacon Mark, after pouring his heart and his ministry into our parish is going to be moving to be closer to his kids (a beautiful and loving thing!) We will miss his dedication and service. Please mark your calendars for a thank you celebration that we will be having for him on May 24th following the 11:00 am Sunday Mass. Also, with his departure, unfortunately it will no longer be sustainable to have a daily communion service at 6:30am. For those of you who may be looking for an earlier Mass time than our 8:00 Mass – I know that St. Thomas in Crystal Lake, and St. Theresa in Palatine both offer a 6:30am Mass, and that St. Margaret Mary in Algonquin offers a 6:45am Mass Monday-Friday. Starting this Monday, we will be bringing back the praying of the Rosary at 7:15 leading up to the 8:00 daily Mass.

I will be heading out this Sunday, the 3rd, with a group of parishioners to lead them on a Pilgrimage throughout the shrines and churches of France. Please pray for us and know that you can follow along by watching the "Morning Minute" each day on our parish YouTube channel as I'll be posting videos about our experiences over there.
