## Grateful for One Year Among You

As I approach my first anniversary here at SS. Peter and Paul Parish, Cary, IL this coming Father's Day weekend, my heart is filled with gratitude to God and to all of you. 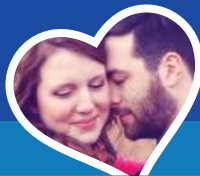
