## From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As the school year draws to a close, and many will reflect back upon it, I wanted to share with you a beautiful prayer known as St. Ignatius of Loyola's "Consciousness Examen" that allows us to reflect upon each day in order to become more aware of God's constant presence with us hour by hour.

### "Consciousness Examen"

My recommendation is that you prayer this prayer in the evening or at night, so that you can look back on the events of the day. . . the goal also is NOT to simply "Get-Through" the steps, but to take you time, really reflecting and allowing God to slowly help things surface in your mind and your heart. The whole process should take 5-15 minutes.

So, the 1st step is to make a prayer of GRATITUDE: - In this you begin by thinking about the day, and trying to call to mind things that went well, things that brought you joy, and things that put a smile on your face. They could be big things or possibly just the tiniest little place where through a small gesture of something you noticed, God was trying to say "I love you." The most important part of this step of gratitude is that you consciously become aware of the fact that each of these bright spots of your day are placed where God is showing you His love. You complete this step by thanking God for these gifted and blessed moments.

Next, the 2nd step is to pray a prayer to the Holy Spirit for ENLIGHTENMENT – What you are doing here is asking God to accompany you as you continue this prayer, so that as you prepare to reflect even deeper upon your day in the third step – that this reflection will not simply be a mental exercise, but that it will truly be a joint exercise in which God leads you to see things now that He was trying to show you throughout the day. So, this 2nd step of praying for enlightenment may seem simple but it is crucially important because we need God's grace to pray and we also need to remind ourselves that this prayer is a journey with God

The 3rd step is truly the heart of the Examen – this third step is REFLECTION over the events of the day. During this time of reflection you consider how it is that through your thoughts, words, and actions - you have responded to God's acts of love for you today. Have you been aware of his presence? Have you acted as He would have you do? If for a moment you thought to yourself that the right thing to do in a certain situation would be you should respond in a certain way, did you follow through with it or take an easier route? Essentially this third step is a place to allow God to show you where He was calling you, what He was asking of you, and to see how it was that you responded to Him. Quite possibly during this step you may see a way in which God was present and even calling out to you, but where you were completely unaware of His presence. 2 important things to take note of here are the facts that God doesn't point out areas where we missed the mark because he wants to bring us down, rather He does so precisely because He wants to pick us up and to help us to become more aware of where to look for Him in the future – the 2nd thing is that I hope you can see why this prayer is so important, it's because if we don't take time to try to see these things, and to become aware of how we can easily miss seeing where God is present, then we're going to remain right where we are and we will always continue to miss out. That's why this prayer and in particular this step is so important – it's because it takes us from where we are at right now, and it leads us to a deeper appreciation and awareness of God's unique and particular love for us.

The 4th step is to ask God for FORGIVENESS for the places in which you just became aware of in which you may have responded to situations in a sinful manner. The fact of the matter is that all of us, if we take time to reflect back on our day, will become aware of times and places in which we acted more in line with our own will than God's. As with any consideration of sin, and any act of asking forgiveness from God, it is crucial that we keep in mind that God is so merciful and that He is waiting with open arms to forgive us before we even ask.

Finally, the 5th Step – which I really love – is where we PREPARE for the day to come – At this point we apply what God is showing us about His love, His presence, and His desire to abide with us and to assist us throughout each day . . . we apply all this to our upcoming day. So, during this step we look forward to the coming day and we consider places we'll go, the people we'll encounter, and the things that will be asked of us. At this point we then pre-emptively ask God to show us how He will be right by our side as well as planning ahead of time how God will ask us to act. Making this preparation will assuredly enable you to follow God more closely.

I hope that you give it a real shot to try to pray it each day. Happy reflecting!

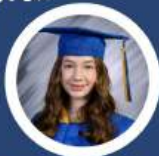

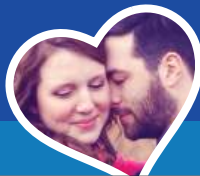
