From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

As summer arrives, many of us look forward to a change of pace. School schedules end, vacations begin, family gatherings fill our calendars, and long-awaited projects finally get our attention. Summer often feels like an opportunity to catch up on all the things we haven't had time to do during the rest of the year. Yet amid all the activity, God extends a different invitation, one that is just as important as any item on our to-do list. He says, "Be still and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10).

Stillness is not something that comes naturally in our busy world. Even during vacation, our days can become packed with travel plans, social events, and endless distractions. We may find ourselves rushing from one enjoyable activity to another without ever slowing down enough to notice the presence of God. But summer can be more than a season of activity; it can also be a season of reflection. Whether sitting quietly on a porch, watching a sunset over a lake, taking a morning walk, or enjoying a conversation with loved ones, we can choose to create moments of stillness. In those moments, we step back from the constant demands of life and allow God to remind us who He is and who we are in His sight.

Taking time to be still helps us see the bigger picture. We remember that our lives are not measured by productivity, accomplishments, or how many tasks we complete. Rather, our lives are gifts from a loving Father who continually pours out His grace upon us. When we pause and reflect, we begin to recognize the countless blessings that often go unnoticed—the gift of family and friends, the beauty of creation, the strength to face challenges, the comfort of faith, and the countless ways God provides for us each day.

Stillness also helps us recognize how God is loving us in the present moment. So often we look for God in extraordinary experiences while overlooking the ordinary blessings right in front of us. His love is revealed in a child's laughter, in a shared meal, in a safe journey, in a word of encouragement, and in the peace that comes from knowing we are never alone. The Lord is constantly at work in our lives, but we need moments of quiet to see Him clearly.

This summer, as you enjoy time with family and friends and take part in the activities that bring joy and renewal, consider setting aside a few minutes each day for prayerful reflection. Thank God for His blessings. Bring Him your hopes and concerns. Ask Him to help you recognize His presence throughout your day. Allow Him to speak to your heart in the silence. The world tells us to fill every moment. God invites us to receive every moment as a gift. May this summer be not only a season of recreation and rest, but also a season of deeper awareness of God's love. In the midst of vacations, gatherings, and summer adventures, may we hear His gentle invitation and respond with open hearts:

"Be still and know that I am God."
