From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

This week at Camp WOW, I had the privilege of spending time with our middle school students, and I came away truly amazed. Throughout the week, I watched students step into activities that initially made them nervous. Whether it was climbing to new heights, participating in a group challenge, meeting new people, or simply stepping outside their comfort zones, many faced moments of uncertainty and fear.

What struck me most was what happened next. Once they took that first step, their fears often began to melt away. The thing they had worried about became something they enjoyed. Their hesitation turned into confidence. Their apprehension gave way to joy. Again and again, I saw students discover that what seemed intimidating from a distance often became a source of growth, accomplishment, and even fun.

As I reflected on their experiences, I couldn't help but think about how God works in our lives. So often, God invites us to take steps that feel uncomfortable. Maybe it's having a difficult conversation, standing up for what is right, speaking honestly about our faith, forgiving someone who has hurt us, or trying something new that may be the next step in God's plan for us.

While God never promises that every step will be easy, He does promise to walk with us through it. Just as our students discovered that courage often leads to unexpected joy, we may find that the opportunities God places before us are not obstacles to fear but invitations to grow. On the other side of our discomfort may be deeper faith, stronger relationships, new opportunities, and a clearer understanding of God's will for our lives.

Camp WOW reminded me that courage isn't the absence of fear, it's choosing to move forward despite it. May we all be willing to take those next faithful steps, trusting that God is leading us toward something good.

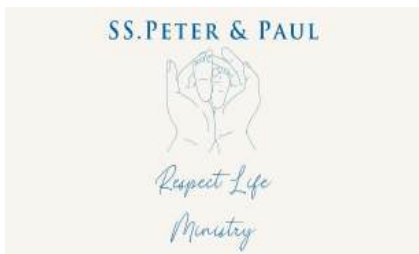

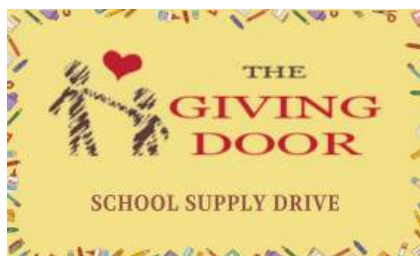
