From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

IT HAS HAPPENED!!!!

With a heart overflowing with gratitude, I want to thank the many parishioners who have generously committed themselves to spending one hour each week before our Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. Because of their faithfulness and sacrifice, we are now able to offer 2 days a week where Adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will be available from morning till evening for our entire parish family!

You will be able to encounter Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in prayer and adoration in the Church:

Tuesdays: 8:30 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Thursdays: 8:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.

(with Spanish Mass from 6:00–6:30 p.m. on Thursdays, and the potential of a pause of Adoration on days that a funeral is scheduled in the morning)

This expansion is much more than an addition to our schedule. It is an invitation. It is an opportunity for every person in our parish to come and spend time with Jesus, truly present in the Holy Eucharist. In a world filled with noise, pressure, anxiety, and constant demands, Jesus offers something that cannot be found anywhere else. He offers His presence. He offers rest for weary hearts. He offers a refuge from fear and uncertainty. He offers the love, acceptance, and belonging for which every human heart longs. Many people spend years searching for peace, fulfillment, identity, and purpose. We often look for these things in success, possessions, entertainment, relationships, or accomplishments. While these may have their place, none of them can satisfy the deepest desires of the human heart. We were made for God, and our hearts find their true home only in Him.

When we sit before Jesus in the Eucharist, we do not come merely to think about Him. We come to be with Him. We come to the One who knows us completely and loves us perfectly. We come to the One who carries our burdens, heals our wounds, and reminds us that we are His beloved children. The saints consistently testify that time spent before the Blessed Sacrament changes lives. It deepens faith, strengthens families, brings clarity in times of confusion, and opens hearts to the transforming grace of God. Many people who begin with just a few minutes discover a peace and joy that they never expected. Whether you come for five minutes, thirty minutes, or several hours, we warmly invite you to stop by whenever you are able during these Adoration hours. Bring your joys and your struggles. Bring your questions and your gratitude. Bring your weariness and your hopes. Simply come and be with Jesus.

Again, we extend our profound thanks to those adorers whose weekly commitment has made this possible. Their generosity is creating opportunities for countless others to encounter Christ and experience His love. May our parish become ever more deeply rooted in the Eucharist, drawing strength, healing, and hope from the Heart of Jesus, who waits for us with open arms.

So let us take Jesus up on His beautiful and generous offer: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest."

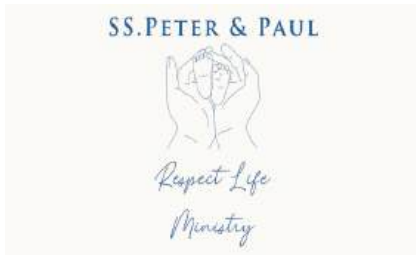
