From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend I'm excited that I have the privilege of accompanying a group of our high school teens to the Steubenville Youth Conference. Every year, this experience is a tremendous gift, not only for our young people, but also for me as a priest. In the midst of busy schedules, constant notifications, and the endless demands of daily life, Steubenville provides something increasingly rare: dedicated time set apart for God. For an entire weekend, thousands of young people gather to pray, worship, encounter the sacraments, and listen for the voice of the Lord. It is inspiring to witness their openness to God's grace and to see how He continues to work in their hearts.

As I prepare for this weekend, I find myself reflecting on a question that all of us can ask: When was the last time I intentionally set aside a significant amount of time simply to be with the Lord? Not time spent rushing through prayers or fitting God into the margins of a busy day, but time devoted to listening. Time spent allowing Him to speak His love into our hearts. Time spent remembering who we are as His beloved sons and daughters. So often we approach prayer with a list of things we want to tell God. Yet God also desires to speak to us. He wants to remind us that we are loved, that we belong to Him, and that our worth is found not in our accomplishments or failures, but in our identity as His children. Whether it is a retreat, an hour before the Blessed Sacrament, a quiet morning with Scripture, or simply an intentional period of silence, I encourage each of us to find time to step away from the noise and make room for the Lord. Give Him the opportunity to love you, strengthen you, and build you up.

Please keep our teens, chaperones, and all those attending the conference in your prayers this weekend. May the Lord use this time to draw them—and all of us—more deeply into His love.
