Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Celebrating the the 250th anniversary of our nation's freedom has made me think

about the true gift of freedom at its deepest level. As Americans, we are grateful for the many freedoms we enjoy. The ability to worship freely, to speak openly, and to participate in the life of our communities are blessings that should never be taken for granted. Yet as Christians, we know that even these precious freedoms point to an even greater freedom that no government can grant and no earthly power can take away. Nearly 2,000 years ago, Jesus Christ won for us the greatest freedom of all. Through His Cross and Resurrection, He broke the chains of sin and conquered death itself. He came to set us free and not just from external oppression, but from everything that keeps us from becoming the people God created us to be.

Too often our culture speaks of freedom as the ability to do whatever we want. The Gospel presents a richer and more beautiful vision. True freedom is not the absence of limits; it is the ability to choose what is good. True freedom is found when our lives are rooted in Christ and directed toward love. The freedom Christ won for us is a gift, but it is also a gift that must be protected and nurtured. We protect it whenever we choose virtue over vice, forgiveness over resentment, generosity over selfishness, and faith over fear. We protect it when we reject the temptation to let sin rule our hearts and instead seek to follow the Lord more faithfully each day. Every choice we make helps shape the kind of people we become. When we choose honesty, patience, kindness, purity, humility, and self-sacrifice, we grow in the freedom that Christ desires for us. We become more capable of loving God and loving those He has placed in our lives. As we give thanks for the freedoms we enjoy as a nation, let us also remember the greater freedom we have received through Jesus Christ. May we never take that gift for granted. And may we strive each day to live as truly free men and women, choosing lives of virtue and making decisions that bring God's love to our families, our parish, and our world.

3 minutes with Jesus: **Daily Reflection points for the Week**

Sunday

Jesus says, "Come to me... and I will give you rest." What burden, fear, or anxiety do I most need to bring to Jesus today instead of trying to carry it on my own?

Monday

Jesus traveled from Heaven to Earth because He loves you personally. Do I truly believe that Jesus knows me, sees me, and loves me personally—not just humanity in general? What makes that difficult for me to believe?

Tuesday

Jesus invites us to abide in His love rather than abide in fear. Where has fear taken up residence in my heart, and how can I intentionally choose to rest in Jesus' love instead?

Wednesday

Jesus says, "I have a plan and a purpose for you." Am I trusting that God is at work in my life even when I cannot understand what He is doing, or am I trying to control everything myself?

Thursday

Jesus invites us to hand over every fear and let Him carry it. What fear or burden have I picked back up after giving it to Jesus, and what would it look like to truly leave it in His hands today?

Friday

Jesus gives us the gift of His Sacred Heart in the Eucharist. When I receive Jesus in Holy Communion, do I approach Him expecting to receive His love, peace, and strength, or has the gift become too familiar?

Saturday

Jesus says, "I am always with you... You are never alone." As I look back over this week, where did I notice Jesus walking with me, and how is He inviting me to trust Him more in the week ahead?

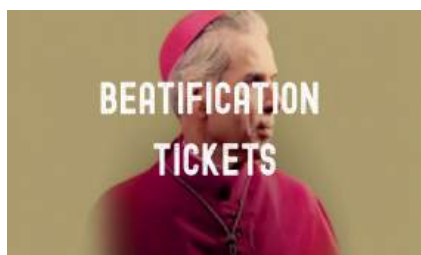
Pray with us on Mondays!

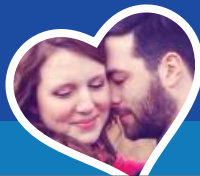
