From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

As many of you know, I recently had the opportunity to take some vacation time. I came home grateful for the beauty I experienced, the places I visited, and the

memories that were made. Yet what I found most refreshing wasn't simply the destination—it was something much deeper.

On this vacation, I made a conscious effort to spend more time than ever before simply being still in the presence of God. Rather than feeling the need to fill every hour, see every sight, or accomplish everything on my itinerary, I intentionally left room for silence, prayer, and listening. I still enjoyed everything my destination had to offer, but I wasn't trying to squeeze every last drop out of each day.

Instead, I asked the Lord to maximize each moment through His grace.

What I discovered is that true rest is not merely the absence of work or the presence of recreation. It is allowing the Lord to renew our minds, restore our hearts, and remind us that our deepest satisfaction is found in Him. Recreation is a gift from God, but even the most beautiful places and exciting experiences cannot fill the longing that only Christ can satisfy.

As we move past the halfway point of summer, many families are beginning to think about a new school year, changing schedules, and the return of familiar routines. Before life speeds up again, perhaps the Lord is inviting each of us to do something simple but profound: to be still with Him.

Maybe that means spending fifteen quiet minutes before the Blessed Sacrament, taking a walk while speaking with God, lingering a little longer after Mass, or beginning each morning with Scripture before reaching for your phone. These moments may seem small, but they create space for God to work.

Psalms 46 reminds us, "Be still, and know that I am God." In that stillness, the Lord gives us something the world cannot offer. He provides a peace that runs deeper than entertainment, a joy that outlasts a vacation, and a rest that refreshes not only our bodies but our souls.

My prayer for all of us is that we will allow the Lord to give us that kind of rest. May we make time to slow down, to listen, and to let Him satisfy our hearts in a way that no amount of activity ever could.

What Is God Asking of You?

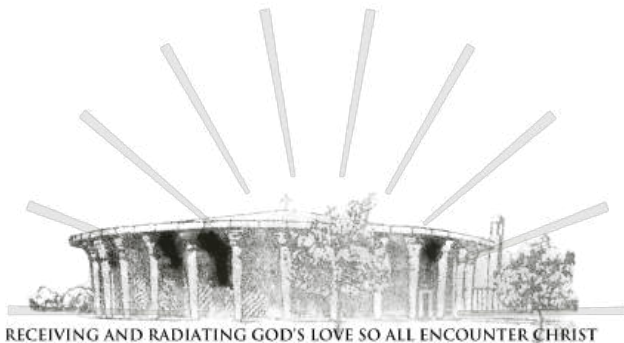

What are you willing to give for the sake of the kingdom of God? Often, we begin a discussion like this with a story or a few leading thoughts. However, if we are to be serious about who we claim to be as Christians, there should be no beating around the bush. The question is not only important for each of us and our relationship with our God, but it should be important for the relationship each of us has with the entire Body of Christ. Like any good team or family, I need you to have my back, and I need to have yours. If one of us is going to lay it on the line and be all in for our faith, then we all need to be as well.

If only all the Christians of the world felt the same way. In some parts of the world, Christians are still being martyred for their faith. Others must worship underground and avoid the government-led police. Then there are those who seem to take faith for granted, and because little is asked by their friends or parish, they give nothing. It is quite a contrast of situations.

On this day, it may seem like little is being asked of you and I by God. Is that because we aren't being asked or because we aren't listening? If you are counting on me and I am on you, we should figure this out sooner than later. Of course, I suspect we actually do know the answer, don't we?

St. Ignatius of Loyola

"Act as if everything depended on you; trust as if everything depended on God"



On July 31, the Church celebrates St. Ignatius of Loyola, whose remarkable conversion reminds us that God can transform even our most unexpected moments into opportunities for grace.

As a young soldier, Ignatius dreamed of military glory until a serious battle injury changed the course of his life. During his recovery, he read the lives of the saints and discovered a new purpose: following Christ wholeheartedly. That encounter with God led him to found the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits) and to become one of the Church's greatest spiritual guides.

One of St. Ignatius' lasting gifts is the Spiritual Exercises—a series of prayers and meditations that help people grow closer to God by recognizing His presence in everyday life and discerning His will. Through reflection on the movements of the heart, the Exercises invite us to deepen our relationship with Christ and respond more fully to His call to discipleship.

St. Ignatius often encouraged people to "find God in all things." His life reminds us that holiness isn't reserved for extraordinary people or extraordinary moments. God meets us in our daily work, our joys, our struggles, and even our setbacks, gently leading us closer to Him.

This week, take a few moments to ask yourself: Where have I experienced God at work in my life, and how is He inviting me to follow Him more closely today?

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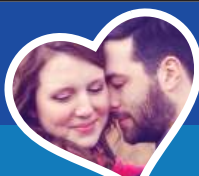
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
