From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Last week, several members of our staff and I had the opportunity to attend the Great Catholic Parishes conference. While there were many practical ideas shared,

one theme kept coming up over and over again: the mission of the Church is not simply to keep programs running or events happening. Our mission is to make disciples of Jesus Christ.

That may sound obvious, but it's surprisingly easy to drift into "maintenance mode." We can become so focused on calendars, meetings, ministries, and events that we lose sight of the deeper purpose behind them. Success is not ultimately measured by attendance numbers, full schedules, or even how smoothly things run. The real question is this: Are we helping people encounter Jesus more deeply, grow as His disciples, and become part of a faith-filled community?

As a parish, we're going to begin looking at everything we do through this lens. We'll be asking ourselves, How does this help people know Christ more deeply? How does it help form disciples? That doesn't necessarily mean we'll do many more things, but rather doing a lot of what we already do but with greater purpose and intentionality. I'm excited to see where the Lord leads us as we continue striving to become the parish He is calling us to be.

This challenge isn't just for our staff or parish leaders. This week I want to invite you to look at every aspect of your own life through the same lens. Specifically ask yourself: "What is the purpose behind the things that I do? and will I achieve what I hope to achieve by doing things the same way I've always done them?"

It's possible to become very good at checking boxes, finishing tasks, staying busy, and accomplishing our to-do lists while unintentionally missing the very goal those tasks were meant to achieve. The Christian life isn't about simply getting things done. It's about becoming more like Christ and helping others do the same.

May the Lord give all of us the wisdom to keep our eyes fixed not merely on the work before us, but on the mission He has entrusted to us.

Sunday

Thursday

When Peter focused on the wind and waves, he began to sink. What distractions or fears keep my eyes off Jesus, and how can I refocus on Him today?

Friday

Jesus immediately reached out His hand to save Peter. When have I experienced God's help or mercy just when I needed it most? How can I thank Him?

Saturday

After witnessing the miracle, the disciples proclaimed, "Truly, you are the Son of God." As I leave Mass today, how can my words and actions proclaim my faith in Jesus to those around me?

"No really, what is a Deacon?"

I was asked this question by someone who truly wanted to know because they just didn't want to just assume they understood what a Deacon is. So here I will try to explain/ describe what we are.

Here at Sts. Peter and Paul we have 6 Deacons. Permanent Deacons, permanent meaning we will not be ordained to the Priesthood.

First things first, in the Church there are two types of people. Those who have received the Sacrament of Holy Orders, considered Clergy, and those who have not, who are considered lay people. In their 3rd year of seminary men seeking ordination to the Priesthood are ordained Transitional Deacons. Which means in about a year they will be ordained a Priest. Permanent Deacons are not expected to be ordained a Priest. I have a fellow classmate whose wife died and he went on to become a Priest, and is now serving in the Diocese of Belleville Illinois. But that is the exception not the rule.

Even though we don't like to be understood by what we can or can't do it is an easy way to start to understand our role. Deacons assist the Priest at Mass, proclaim the Gospel may preach the homily, invite the faithful to share the sign peace and dismiss at the end of Mass. We also baptize, witness marriages, preside at funerals and burial services when appropriate. However a Deacon cannot celebrate Mass, hear confessions or anoint the sick. Having said that your Deacons do many other things. From bringing the Eucharist to the sick, instructing people in the faith, being a spiritual guide, leading prayer services or Eucharistic adoration, preparing for the major holidays, and sometimes just lending a helping hand. Being a Deacon allows us to use our personal talents to help others encounter Christ. I always found encountering people where they were spiritually and walking with them to deepen their relationship with God the most fulfilling aspect of my ministry.

Just like everyone else Deacons can stumble going down the path towards God, that is why I am asking for your prayers for all of the Clergy, here and everywhere. Knowing that all of you remain in our prayers.

St. Clare of Assisi

*"Totally love Him, who gave
Himself totally for your love."*



St. Clare of Assisi (1194–1253) was born into a wealthy, influential Catholic family in Assisi, Italy. At age 12, her family arranged for her to marry, but Clare pleaded to wait until she was 18, and they eventually agreed.

As a teenager, Clare heard

a priest named Francis (St. Francis of Assisi) preach and was inspired by his life of poverty, community, and service to the poor. She realized her calling was to "live for the Gospel." With the bishop's permission, she left her family to join Francis and his followers, exchanging her fine clothing for a simple robe and veil and cutting her hair as a sign of her commitment to religious life.

After a time with the Benedictines, Clare was joined by her sister. To protect them from family members determined to bring them home, Francis established them at San Damiano, where they founded the Order of the Poor Ladies of San Damiano.

The Eucharist, daily Mass, and adoration were at the heart of their lives. Their commitment to poverty distinguished them from other religious communities. After the order received papal approval, Clare wrote its Rule of Life based on the teachings of St. Francis—the first known monastic rule written by a woman.

St. Clare died at age 59, just one day after her Rule was approved. Her community became known as the Poor Clares in her honor. St. Clare, pray for us!

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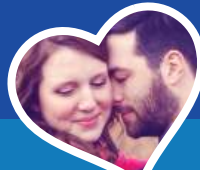
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
