From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

I'll miss you all on Sunday because I once again have the opportunity to celebrate Mass at Wrigley Field! The group that organizes and makes this possible is "Catholic Athletes for Christ," and they have worked

to establish Catholic Mass at nearly every MLB stadium for players, coaches, broadcasters, team officials, scouts, and stadium personnel each Sunday that there's a game! I love being a part of this because the organization helps promote a beautiful aspect of our Faith which is not simply to believe, but to live out our Faith as disciples. These stadium Masses bring the sacramental life of the Church into the environment where these people actually live and work. It gets at something very Catholic about the Incarnation and the sacramental life. The Church doesn't say, "You're a baseball player during baseball hours and a Catholic afterward." Each Catholic athlete is supposed to live and lead from their relationship with Jesus inside the clubhouse, on the road, in the locker room, at the stadium, and on the field. I'll highlight the "on the road" part because When a team is traveling, anyone from the visiting team is welcome to attend Mass at the stadium they're visiting. So "Yes" I may have members of the Cardinals at my Mass on Sunday, and I'll be happy to have them because our Faith in Christ transcends their terrible choice to affiliate themselves with the Cubs biggest rival! It's a beautiful reminder that we come together from all walks of life yet are members of the same family of God, called to be there for each other in the midst of life's storms.

I invite you this week to spend time praying and asking God to reveal to you ways in which you can intentionally live out your Faith and your life in Christ at work, at home, in the grocery store, or even when you're in your car. One of the deepest truths is when we leave Mass we aren't done for the week, rather we're being sent out on mission to make more disciples. Ask God to show you how He wants to work in and through you this week, and rejoice to welcome and acknowledge His presence in every aspect of your life.

3 minutes with Jesus

Daily Reflection points for the Week

Based on *Matthew 15:21-28*

Sunday

The Canaanite woman does not give up when her prayer seems unanswered. She continues to trust and brings her need to Jesus. Am I willing to keep turning to Jesus, even when His answer seems delayed?

Monday

The woman's prayer is simple: "Lord, help me." Our prayers do not need to be complicated. Jesus wants us to bring Him exactly what is on our hearts. What do I need to place in Jesus' hands today?

Tuesday

Sometimes God seems silent, but silence does not mean absence. The Canaanite woman continued to trust even when she did not immediately receive an answer. Do I trust that Jesus is near, even when I do not hear Him?

Wednesday

The Canaanite woman persevered despite obstacles and discouragement. Her persistence became an expression of her faith. Where might Jesus be asking me not to give up?

Thursday

Jesus reminds us that great faith can be found in unexpected people. God can use anyone to teach us something about Himself. Who has God placed in my life who can teach me about faith?

Friday

The woman knows she needs Jesus and humbly asks for His help. We, too, are invited to admit that we cannot do everything on our own. Where do I need to let go of my pride and ask Jesus for help?

Saturday

Jesus praises the woman for her great faith. Her faith was shown by trusting Him and refusing to walk away. What is one area of my life where Jesus is inviting me to trust Him more?

What is prayer?

In High School religion class Monsignor Schwartz stood in front of our class brilliantly and passionately delivering the answer to the question. “When we pray, we pray TO the Father, THROUGH the Son, IN the Holy Spirit.” I reflected and heard him describe the Church’s teaching on prayer...and the Trinity. I was in the front row and was delighted by this breakthrough and exclaimed, “I get it!” He walked to the front of my desk and looked down and said, “No my Son, it’s a mystery...”

But this explanation continues to guide me/us on our relationship to the Trinity and the path of our offering of prayer.

Theologically, the best exclamation that I have heard of prayer is that it is our, “Radical (or grounded) response to life.” It is an expression that takes an inner journey within us and emerges from our inner-most being. In fact, - it has been said as a test, “No heart – no prayer”.

It is a reminder that when we offer a prayer, whether is an acclamation of praise, in contrition for a misstep, or in an offering of gratitude – that if it does not come from the heart that it is not prayer, but maybe just words.

Meister Eckhart would say that if we had one prayer to offer it would be, “Thank You!”

It’s interesting that the Church teaches that the ultimate prayer that can be said and participated in is the Eucharistic prayer. It is a Greek word meaning Thanksgiving.

Prayer and meditation are something for us to explore and focus on. Have you every heard that, “Seven days without prayer, makes one weak”? We need prayer – expressing and listening. It gives us strength; it fortifies and guides us. St. Thomas Aquinas tells us that that God’s grace is ‘Super-Abundant!’ And it’s a prayer away!

It is important to note that in the Gospel stories of Martha and Mary that Jesus compliments Mary on her ‘contemplation’. But the author leaves out something that Jesus would also say – that Martha in her spiritual maturity was not only in contemplation in Jesus’ presence but also serving in prayer.

Prayer can take many forms. It can be formal, spoken prayers – it can be in response to music or art, as an example. It is not only internal, but external. Prayer may be in service to others. It is prayerful to love.

St. Pius X

“Holy Communion is the shortest and safest way to Heaven.”



St. Pius X, born Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, was born in what is now Veneto, Italy. He became the 257th Pope, serving from 1903 until his death in 1914. His deep love for the Eucharist was evident from a young age and remained central throughout his life.

As Pope, St. Pius X emphasized the importance of developing a personal relationship with Jesus through the Eucharist. He encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion and worked to make the Sacrament more accessible to all Catholics, regardless of age or social status.

One of his most significant contributions was lowering the age for First Communion. In 1910, he established that children who had reached the age of reason— generally around seven years old—could receive Holy Communion. He believed children could receive the profound graces of the Eucharist and that early, frequent reception would help establish a strong foundation for lifelong faith.

St. Pius X also worked to defend Catholic teaching against modernism, which challenged traditional Church doctrine. In his encyclical *Pascendi Dominici Gregis*, he condemned modernist errors and sought to safeguard the integrity of Catholic teaching.

Known as the “Pope of the Eucharist,” St. Pius X left a lasting legacy of devotion to Christ truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. Interestingly, he was also the first pope to use a typewriter for his encyclicals.

St. Pius X, Pope of the Eucharist, pray for us!

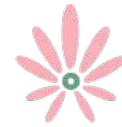
