From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Being a member of the Catholic Church and in turn being a member of this family of Saints Peter and Paul is never meant to be simply about showing up at Mass, learning and knowing things in a vacuum, and obeying some rules and regulations! Rather, it's about knowing and loving God in a dynamic relationship and with God as our Father, being a part of this beautiful family with others who are our brothers and sisters through sharing the same loving Heavenly Father! We are meant to know that we belong and are a part of something bigger than ourselves that exists to support us, give us love, and provide us with a community.

Today I want to highlight 3 opportunities that we have starting soon, and I'm hoping that one of them may be something that can feed your own hunger for living within the home of our parish family:

For **Husbands and Fathers: That Man is You** is an opportunity to gather with other men who desire to establish brotherhood, share what works for them and where they struggle, learn how to be humble yet courageous leaders, while growing deeper in Faith as they become men after God's own Heart. It's a great time of fellowship, food, and sharing that provides what many men search for yet struggle to find. I'm excited that this year, after over 10 years of providing a place for men to strengthen their lives together, the curriculum for the content of the program is going back to the start with updated material. I mention this because it's a perfect time to start for the first time OR to come back and check it out again if you've been away for a while. The first session for the year will be on **Saturday, September 12th** and men are encouraged to show up between 6:00-6:15am. Breakfast will be provided! Please come check it out! For **Women: Walking with Purpose** provides an opportunity to grow together on the Faith Journey of life. This incredibly fun ministry walks through scripture in a way that makes living faith on a day-to-day level make sense. I will say from my own experience that each time I walk through the parish hall while the women are meeting I hear so much laughter and discussion happening that I feel like I'm missing out! Last year was the first year of this ministry being offered at our parish and I'm excited to see the friendships and community that grown out of it this year. For anyone who is looking for a place to belong, to be able to share their ups and downs, and to know that they aren't alone to walk the walk that we're all called to be on as the pressures of life try to get in the way, this group is for you! Starting on **September 15th** and running **every other Tuesday from 6:30-8:00pm** this semester's focus is on the book of Colossians and runs through Dec. 1st. For those **Wanting to Become Catholic or Learning More: OCIA** is the place to be on **Sunday mornings from 10:30am-12:00pm starting on September 13th!** Fr. Simon and an incredibly dedicated and passionate team lead this family community aimed at helping you join our family (if you're not Catholic) or understand the depth of the gift it is to be a part of the family (if you're already Catholic). All of us search for meaning in our day-to-day lives and sometimes it's apparent and obvious in front of us, but I know from my own experience that it can oftentimes be hard to stay focused on the meaning and purpose of everything. Deepening our Faith and understanding of the relationship that God calls us to, the Family we're freely offered belonging in, and the reasons why Faith matters is truly a life changing opportunity that changes lives forever! *I have seen the Lord.
I have heard His voice.
And I know He lives.
And I know He lives.*

How many times have you wanted to be able to speak those words yourself? How many times have you wondered where God is?

These are not uncommon questions. They are asked every day by many people.

We are so busy and preoccupied with so many things, we often fail to see the Lord, who is present among us.

More than 35 years ago I attended a Cursillo Retreat with many other men from Sts. Peter and Paul Parish. (The ladies had their own retreat as well.) The experience was wonderful and had a permanent effect on my life. As the retreat ended, we were asked to consider forming small groups that would meet weekly. Four of us agreed to do that.

The most important part of our weekly meeting for me was that each of us had to share our moment closest to Christ during the past week. The 30-minute meetings each week were easy at first but after the high of the retreat wore off, keeping the meetings going became more difficult. Sharing our "moment closest to Christ" became the link that held us together. We met for many years.

We are taught from a young age that God is always with us. If I asked you to share with me where you saw or heard God in the last 7 days, you may well have to give it some serious thought. God is always there!

What was your moment closest to Christ this past week? I would suggest that you find a friend(s) and commit to sharing your answer with them at a specific time each week. It could be your spouse, a friend or even your family at mealtime.

Do it!

It will bring your awareness of Christ to the front of your mind like you will not believe. The experiences you have with Jesus can be beautiful and overwhelming.

Have you seen the Lord? Have you heard His voice?

Tell me where, when and how. I NEED TO KNOW!

St. Gregory the Great

"The proof of love is in the works. Where love exists, it works great things."



Saint Gregory the Great lived in a most turbulent time. There were devastating episodes of plague, the sacking of Rome and the breakdown of strong Roman rule, invasions by Lombards and Franks, floods, and a widening gap between imperial Byzantium and the Roman Church.

Often called the father of the medieval papacy and Apostle of the English, Saint Gregory was named Pope by acclamation in 590. Although he was reluctant

to assume this post, preferring the cloistered life, his accomplishments were many. He was an extremely capable manager of Church estates and tenants and is known for his reform of the liturgy. He was instrumental in the consolidation of papal power and led the fight against the many heresies promoted by small Christian groups at the time. Through his prolific correspondence he oversaw monastic life, curtailing the power of grasping bishops, correcting abuses, and enforcing discipline. He was particularly concerned with the conversion of England, sending 40 monks from his monastery to evangelize there.

Saint Gregory died in 604 and was sainted immediately. He is one of four key doctors of the Western Church. Among the miracles attributed to him is a Eucharistic miracle in which the woman who prepared the bread for communion laughed at the consecration, denying the transformation of the bread to the real presence of Jesus. Saint Gregory prayed for the Lord to show the congregation the truth and confirm their belief. The piece of bread transformed into a piece of flesh and then returned to bread, reforming the woman, and strengthening the faith of all.

Daily Reflection points for the Week

Based on *Matthew 16:21-27*

Sunday

"You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." Jesus reminds Peter that God's plan is greater than what we can understand. Sometimes following Jesus means trusting Him even when we don't see the whole picture. *Where is Jesus asking me to trust His plan instead of my own?*

Monday

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself." Following Jesus means putting God first. It doesn't mean we are unimportant; it means learning to choose what is good and loving, even when it isn't the easiest choice. *What is one thing I can put aside today to make more room for God?*

Tuesday

"Take up his cross, and follow me." Jesus doesn't promise that following Him will always be easy, but He promises that we never carry our crosses alone. *What difficulty can I invite Jesus to walk through with me today?*

Wednesday

"Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it." The world can tell us that happiness comes from getting more for ourselves. Jesus teaches something different: true joy comes from giving ourselves in love. *How can I give my time or attention to someone else today?*

Thursday

"Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." Jesus invites us to discover that our lives have a deeper purpose. *How can I use one of my God-given gifts to serve someone today?*

Friday

"What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" Success, possessions, and recognition cannot give us what only God can give. *What matters most to me right now, and does it bring me closer to Jesus?*

Saturday

"The Son of Man will come... and then he will repay all according to his conduct." Our everyday choices matter. Every act of kindness, patience, forgiveness, and love is an opportunity to follow Jesus more closely. *What is one choice I can make today that reflects the love of Jesus?*

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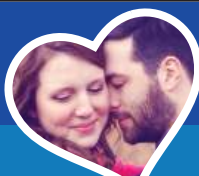
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
