From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

I've been speaking with a LOT of people recently who have mentioned how tired and overwhelmed they feel. And honestly, my thought every time is simply, "Yep, I know how you feel!" As I've been praying about this, I've realized something in my own life: maybe the problem isn't always that I'm working too hard. God will provide what is necessary for whatever He calls us to do. Maybe, instead, I don't always know how to rest well.

And I think that has a lot to do with discipleship. We can often think of discipleship as what we do for God: serving, volunteering, helping, giving. And those things are important. But before we can give, we have to learn how to receive. True rest isn't simply doing nothing or finding something fun to do. It's allowing ourselves to be restored and reminded of who we are: God's beloved sons and daughters. That means coming before the Lord and simply casting our cares upon Him because He loves us. We don't have to present everything perfectly. Sometimes we just need to throw it all before Him and say, "Lord, I can't carry all of this myself." And then stay with Him and let Him carry it.

I'll admit that I often get this wrong. Sometimes my attempts to rest just involve doing more things, and somehow I end up more tired than when I started! Maybe some of us need to remember that rest isn't something we have to earn. It's something God wants to give us.

So I want to invite you to try something simple: each day, spend five quiet minutes with the Lord. No formula. No agenda. Just talk to Him, give Him what's weighing on you, and be still. It may feel awkward at first, but over time we can learn to recognize His voice in the stillness.

And then there is another important part of discipleship: we aren't meant to do everything ourselves.

Jesus says, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out more laborers for His harvest!" Sometimes we're exhausted because the harvest really IS abundant and the laborers really ARE few. In those moments, we need to ask for help. And asking for help can actually become an opportunity for discipleship. When we invite someone to step in, we're not just getting something off our plate. We're giving someone else the opportunity to use their gifts, serve others, and become more deeply involved in the life and mission of the Church. That's what discipleship looks like: receiving from God and then allowing what we've received to become a gift to others.

So, to wrap this up, I'm going to put my money where my mouth is. If I'm telling you that we need to learn how to rest with the Lord, then I want to invite you to come and do exactly that with me at Eucharistic Adoration. We have Adoration on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and we're especially in need of people to commit to a weekly hour on Thursdays so that we can keep it sustainable. And maybe that's the beautiful thing about this invitation: You can come and rest with Jesus while also helping someone else have that same opportunity. You receive from the Lord and your presence becomes a gift to someone else.

So this week, instead of only asking, "What else do I need to get done?" perhaps ask: "Lord, what do I need to receive from You?" And then, "Who might You be inviting me to ask for help?" We were never meant to follow Jesus alone. We are meant to receive His love, allow Him to carry us, and then become the people through whom He carries others. Happy resting, and I'm so glad to be on this journey of discipleship with you!

St. Hildegard of Bingen

“There is the music of Heaven in all things.”

Saint Hildegard of Bingen was a remarkable 12th-century Benedictine nun, mystic, author, composer, physician, preacher, and theologian. Born in 1098, she began living with a holy woman named Jutta when she was eight years old. Jutta educated Hildegard and eventually formed a community of religious women.

From childhood, Hildegard experienced mystical visions while praying. Though she initially hesitated to share them, she eventually began recording them at the direction of her confessor. Her writings described God's relationship with humanity, Christ's suffering and death, the Church, and the beauty of God's creation. Her visions were examined and affirmed by Church leaders, including Pope Eugene III and St. Bernard of Clairvaux.

Hildegard also composed hymns and sacred music, wrote about medicine and natural history, founded monasteries, and corresponded with popes, Church leaders, rulers, and others who sought her counsel. She courageously spoke about matters she believed required correction, while emphasizing that her wisdom came from God rather than from herself.

Despite chronic illness, Hildegard continued traveling, writing, preaching, and advising others until her death in 1179. In 2012, Pope Benedict XVI declared her a Doctor of the Church, recognizing her significant contribution to the Church's spiritual and theological life.

Daily Reflection points for the Week

Based on Matthew 18:21-35

Sunday

God's mercy is far greater than anything we could ever earn, and He asks us to share that mercy with others.

Who in my life might God be inviting me to forgive?

Monday

Forgiveness is not about pretending that a wrong never happened; it is about refusing to let resentment control our hearts. *What hurt or resentment do I need to place in God's hands today?*

Tuesday

When we remember how often God has forgiven and been patient with us, it becomes easier to be patient with the imperfections of others. *How has remembering God's mercy changed the way I treat someone who has hurt me?*

Wednesday

Jesus calls us to forgive generously, not because the other person has earned it, but because mercy is at the heart of Christian life. *Am I waiting for someone to deserve my forgiveness before I offer it?*

Thursday

Forgiveness can be a gradual journey, but every step toward letting go of anger can open our hearts more fully to God's peace. *What is one small step I can take toward forgiveness today?*

Friday

We cannot receive God's mercy deeply while refusing to show mercy to those around us. *Where might I be asking for mercy from God while withholding it from someone else?*

Saturday

The freedom that comes from forgiveness is a gift—not only to the person we forgive, but also to our own hearts. *What would change in my heart if I chose to stop keeping score?*

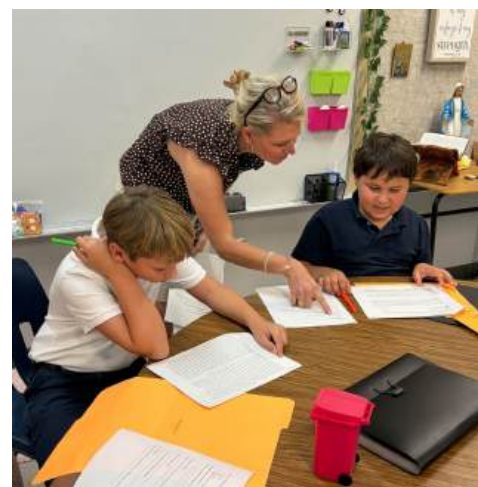

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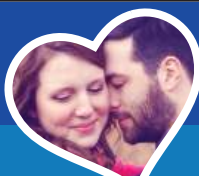
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
