Giving: Putting Our Faith Into Action

Talking about giving can sometimes be uncomfortable—for clergy and parishioners alike. But perhaps we are looking at it from the wrong perspective.

God doesn't ask us for our dollars. He asks us to care for one another.

Jesus calls us to respond to the physical and material needs of those who are struggling. These are the **Corporal**

Works of Mercy:

- **Feed the hungry**
- **Give drink to the thirsty**
- **Clothe the naked**
- **Shelter the homeless**
- **Visit the sick**
- **Visit the imprisoned**
- **Bury the dead**

For many of us, however, these needs can seem distant from our everyday lives. We may not personally encounter someone who is hungry or without clothing. We may see someone experiencing homelessness while we are driving by but not know how to help. Those who are imprisoned may be many miles away.

But that doesn't mean we are unable to help.

Right here in our parish and community are people who encounter these needs every day. Some parishioners serve in prison ministry. Others work directly with people who are hungry, thirsty, homeless, or in need of clothing and other necessities.

These ministries give us an opportunity to live out the Corporal Works of Mercy even when we cannot personally perform each one ourselves.

Sometimes, the best way we can respond to God's call is to **support those who are already doing the work.**

So, when you are invited to give, please consider it more than a financial contribution. Your generosity becomes food for someone who is hungry, assistance for someone without a home, care for someone who is sick, hope for someone who is imprisoned, and companionship for someone who is alone.

International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima

Part 2 - What is the Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima?

The first Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, made according to instructions given by Sister Lucia, was commissioned by the Bishop of Leiria and solemnly crowned by the Archbishop of Evora on May 13, 1947. From that time, the statue began traveling throughout the world, carrying the message of Fatima and calling people to prayer, conversion, peace, and devotion to Our Lady.

The idea for a traveling statue began shortly after World War II. In 1945, a parish priest in Berlin proposed that a statue of Our Lady of Fatima travel throughout Europe, including to the capitals and diocesan cities near the Russian border. The idea gained international support, and the statue began its first journey in 1947.

Over the next five decades, the statue traveled to 64 countries across several continents, some more than once. Because of the many requests for visits, replicas of the original Pilgrim Statue were eventually created. Today, thirteen replicas travel throughout the world, allowing more people to encounter Our Lady of Fatima and her message.

The statue's visits have been associated with large gatherings of people, increased participation in prayer and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and many stories of spiritual renewal. These visits continue to provide an opportunity for people of all ages to come together in prayer and grow in their faith.

Sunday

Sometimes we may initially resist God's invitation, but what matters is having the humility to change our hearts and follow Him through our actions. *Where is God inviting me to move beyond simply saying "yes" and put my faith into action this week?*

Monday

God does not give up on us when we make mistakes or resist His will; He patiently gives us opportunities to turn back and begin again. *Is there something God may be asking me to reconsider or change in my life?*

Tuesday

A sincere change of heart can transform a "no" into a faithful "yes," reminding us that our past does not have to determine our future with God. *What is one small change I can make today to draw closer to God?*

Wednesday

Jesus challenges us to look honestly at whether our actions match the faith we profess with our words. *Do my choices today reflect what I say I believe?*

God's invitation often comes through ordinary opportunities to serve, forgive, encourage, or show love to someone around us. *Where might God be giving me an opportunity to serve Him through another person today?*

Friday

Humility allows us to admit when we have been wrong and to trust that God welcomes us when we turn back to Him. *Is there an apology, act of forgiveness, or change of heart that God may be placing on my heart?*

Saturday

The goal of following Christ is not to appear faithful but to become faithful through the choices we make each day. *What is one concrete way I can put my faith into action this weekend?*

THURSDAY, OCT. 1, 10:30 A.M.

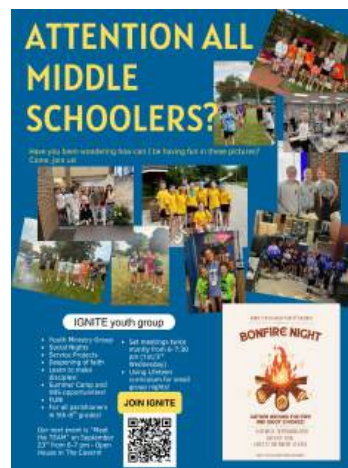
