DEANS'S ADDRESS



DEAN'S ADDRESS Elizabeth Daley, Ph.D. USC School of Cinematic Arts

Elizabeth M. Daley has served as Dean of the USC School of Cinematic Arts since 1991, the longest tenure of a Dean at the University of Southern California. She is the inaugural holder of the Steven J. Ross/Time Warner Dean's Chair.

Daley has strengthened the School's international profile expanding its academic programs, including the addition of cutting-edge research labs; overseeing the construction of a new, state-of-the-art campus; and developing collaborations with industry partners both domestically and globally, across the spectrum of visual media, including film, television, video games, interactive and emerging media. Under Daley's leadership, SCA has added three new divisions: Animation and Digital Arts, Interactive Media and Games, and Media Arts + Practice; established the Entertainment Technology Center, a think tank focused on the impact of new technologies: built the Robert Zemeckis Center for Digital Arts; established 33 endowed faculty positions; and formed successful partnerships with a variety of entertainment and technology companies. The School currently has research partnerships focused on virtual reality and immersive technologies, mobile and location-based entertainment, world building, virtual production, interactive architecture, and other emerging areas. Daley has also established successful consulting initiatives in China, India, Japan, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Jordan and the United Arab Emirates.

Before coming to USC, Daley served as Director of Taper Media Enterprises, the for-profit film and television subsidiary of the Mark Taper Forum, and was a producer for MGM/Television. She has also been an independent producer and media consultant. Daley has served on the Board of Directors of Avid Technology, Inc., the Benton Institute for Broadband and Society, and Digital Domain, and is a former chair of the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on Media, Entertainment and Information. She is a member of the Directors Guild of America and the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences.



Emily Chi, Senior Systems Engineering Leader at Waymo

Morning Keynote Fireside Chat Speaker

Emily Chi is a Senior Systems Engineering Leader at Waymo, an autonomous driving technology company with a mission to be the world's most trusted driver.

Hardware and software issues are inevitable in all engineering systems. In her role, Emily oversees the requirements and testing that ensures safe and responsible driving when such issues arise. Her team is also responsible for the requirements and testing of safety-critical operations functions. Prior to joining Waymo in 2016, Emily spent 12 years working on satellite systems at Google and Northrop Grumman. She started her career developing flight software for the James Webb Space Telescope and held roles in a variety of areas, ranging from controls analysis to validation testing to launch and operations.

Emily earned her B.S. in Electrical Engineering and Computer Science from MIT and her M.S. in Electrical Engineering from USC.

As an associate professor of technology and applied computing practice in the Viterbi School of Engineering at the University of Southern California, Dr. Trina Gregory teaches computer programming and technology-focused courses to undergraduate students. She also serves as an associate director of innovation and entrepreneurship under the Viterbi School of Engineering's Office of Technology Innovation and Entrepreneurship (TIE). Under this role, she teaches entrepreneurial skills to engineers and supports student teams with their startup ventures. After earning a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree in Mathematics-Computer Science from UCSD, she worked full-time in the computer science industry for over 13 years developing, writing, and managing software for the Department of Defense. She received a Master of Science (M.S.) degree in Computer Science and a Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) degree in Organizational Change and Leadership from USC. Her research focused on the learning environments for undergraduate engineering students to improve their engineering identity and increase the rates of women graduating with engineering degrees and pursuing engineering careers.




