Outreach at The Journey

Outreach at The Journey is rooted in relationships. We want to show up consistently, listen well, respond to practical needs, and build genuine connections that reflect the love of Jesus.

The Outreach Intern will serve alongside staff members and volunteers to support The Journey's outreach efforts, with most of their time focused on our ministry called Los Vecinos, which means "The Neighbors."

Meet Los Vecinos

Los Vecinos is an outreach ministry focused on building meaningful relationships with Hispanic families in the West County area.

Our hope is to walk with families through everyday life while sharing the love and hope of Jesus. We come alongside families through:

- Tutoring for children
- ESL classes
- Connecting families with counseling and other community resources
- Community workdays that help keep shared spaces clean and safe
- Special events and gatherings
- Consistent friendship and relational support



About the Internship

THROUGHOUT THE INTERNSHIP YOU WILL HAVE OPPORTUNITIES TO:

- Build consistent relationships with children and families
- Learn how tutoring, English classes, and other Los Vecinos programs are planned and supported
- Help prepare materials, supplies, and spaces for ministry activities
- Grow in communicating with volunteers, participants, families, and ministry leaders
- Assist with volunteer coordination, scheduling, transportation, and event logistics
- Participate in community events and practical service projects
- Gain exposure to other outreach initiatives as opportunities and needs arise
- Help strengthen systems for communication, organization, and follow-up

Internship at a Glance

TIME COMMITMENT

Approximately 8 hours per week

TYPICAL SCHEDULE

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30–6:30 p.m.

The schedule may occasionally change because of school breaks, community events, or other ministry needs.

INTERNSHIP TERM

September 2026–May 2027

PRIMARY FOCUS

Los Vecinos, with occasional exposure to other outreach initiatives

LOCATION

The Journey West County and the Los Vecinos community in Manchester, MO

COMPENSATION

This is an unpaid internship with a fixed stipend. Because the internship is designed primarily for learning, development, and ministry experience, the stipend is not based on hours worked or treated as regular wages. Instead, it is intended to help offset everyday living expenses and make it easier for you to set aside time to participate fully in the internship.

Who We Are Looking For

THIS INTERNSHIP MAY BE A GOOD FIT FOR SOMEONE WHO:

- Loves Jesus and desires to grow as His apprentice
- Cares deeply about people and community outreach
- Is relational, approachable, and willing to listen and learn
- Demonstrates humility, reliability, flexibility, and initiative
- Is comfortable serving children, families, volunteers, and ministry leaders
- Is willing to participate in both relational ministry and behind-the-scenes support
- Welcomes coaching, feedback, and accountability
- Can commit consistently to the internship schedule and term

SPEAKING SPANISH IS A SIGNIFICANT ADVANTAGE

Because much of this internship involves serving children and families who primarily speak Spanish, conversational or fluent Spanish would strengthen the intern's ability to communicate, build trust, and participate fully.

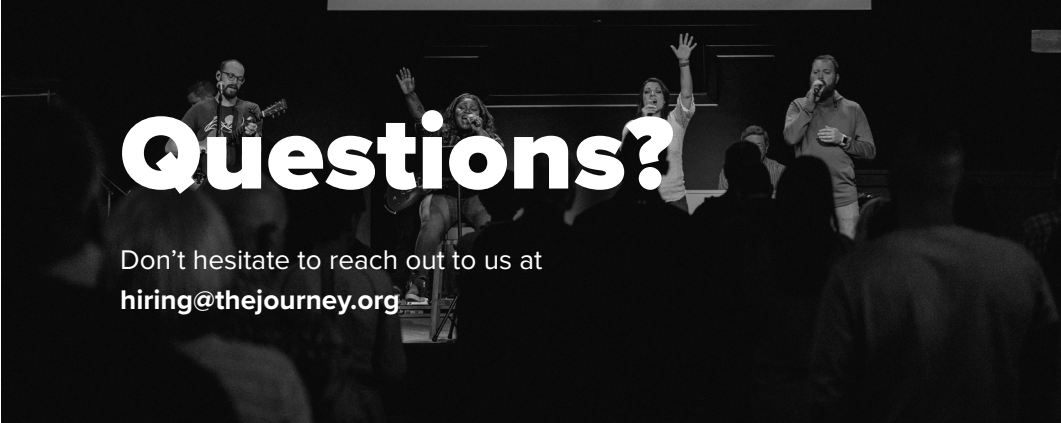
We encourage potential applicants to prayerfully consider whether this is the right opportunity and season for them.
