


Section 1. How To Navigate Your Learner Dashboards

Illustration below (Home Page):



You will have a couple of main pages where you will probably hang out the most. The SKILLINGS Education Home Page being one of them. The Home Page tells you what courses you have been viewing and how many courses you have completed. Don't expect to see any numbers there when you first log in. But they will quickly start mounting up as you start working through different courses and learning paths.


Illustration below (Dashboard):


Illustration below (Achievements):

Section 2. Search For The Individual/Curated Course You Want




Navigating your way around

- Once you are in your dashboard, click on **Content Library**.
- You can choose to view the courses and learning paths as either a list or in grid view by clicking the icon located at the top right side of the screen.


Searching for your courses

• Leave all the boxes under **Content Type** unchecked and type a key word in the search bar and all related courses and learning pathways will appear.






 Tick the Courses box only and type in a key word and this time the search results will bring up all related individual courses with the key word or course tag in its title.



You can see if this is the course you are after by hovering over the {} located next to each course name. You will see the course description and learn more (see below). To select the course, simply CLICK! Once you have selected your course, you are ready to navigate through.



 Tick the Learning Paths box only and once you type in the key word and search, the results will bring up all Learning Pathways that have related courses to your key word that are intended to be complimentary to each other or suggest a possible learning pathway.



Once you click on a **Learning Path** you will see a list of courses that are assigned to that Learning Path category.

This way of navigating provides a complete list of Learning Paths across all course categories whether it be an individual communication course you are after or all course categories containing communication courses. Learning Paths are indexed in alphabetical order, so you just need to scroll down to find the Learning Path you are after.

Each Learning Path has a number of courses for the learner to complete in any order - at their own pace. Learning Paths can be modified for Organizations so that the order of courses must be completed, but this is not a default position for individual members.



You will find below a list of example learning pathways that may be found in each of the Course Libraries and a description of what each Learning Path offers:




Briefs may include project proposals, summaries, breakdowns or scope of work document.

Learn what participants and stakeholders need to be in **meetings** - and what they will discuss to achieve project delivery and expected results.




Learn about the varied processes and stages required to complete a systematic investigation into materials and what sources may be **research**ed to establish facts and mitigate against potential risks.




Learn more about the processes used for making sure your project **procurement** is successful.






Understand the collection of **programs** and individual tasks that are required to achieve positive outcomes in your project delivery.

You may need to attend or schedule and make **presentations** to help your stakeholders understand your projects.






