

SEAWAY KIWANIS TV BINGO

RULES OF PLAY & OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

Beginning September, 2025

Show Frequency

The Seaway Kiwanis TV Bingo show, in partnership with YourTV airs once a week Tuesday nights at 7:00 pm between mid-September and the end of May. There are circumstances when the day of the week has to be switched to Wednesday and these changes will be announced on air as soon as Kiwanis become aware.

Bingo Card Purchase

- Bingo cards are available in a package of 3 cards. Each card can be used to play all 4 games.

Game 1 - T game	Game 3 – Around the Free
Game 2 – X game	Game 4 – Full Card
- Cards are sold in selected convenience stores, grocery stores, lottery kiosks, bar & grilles. A list will be provided each bingo night.
- Each card is dated and colour coded with the date of the show for which it is purchased and is valid only for that date. The card serial number will indicate to Seaway the week for which the card pertains.
- Each card contains a different card number located in the free space in the centre of the card and is repeated on the bottom right hand corner of that card. This card number is matched by a number in the Seaway Kiwanis TV Bingo computer software

program and is used to verify that specific card(s) being played is/are winning cards or that game.

- Each card contains the telephone number used to contact Seaway Kiwanis TV Bingo to claim a winning card.

Prize Board

T game - \$500.	Around the Free game - \$600.
X game - \$500.	Full card -\$1,000.

- The game prize will be split among all winners for that game and the amount will be rounded up to the nearest dollar

TV Bingo Rules of Play

(a) The caller will call a new ball number every 10-15 seconds. The caller will stop calling ball numbers when the computer software indicates there is a potential winning card. The game will be paused for 1 minute to give the potential game winner time to call. If there is no call, additional number(s) will be called until another potential winning card is identified by the computer. The game will again be halted and the process repeats until a winner calls the TV Bingo telephone line.

(b) Should a player not be able to get through on the telephone because of technical difficulties, their winning card can still be verified during the show as the control room has a list of all potential game winning numbers. There is also a voice mail option when calling the TV Bingo line and this can be used.

(c) Clear cards after each of the first 2 games. Do not clear cards after game 3 as numbers carry over to game 4.

(d) All games must be completed and winners determined by 8:00 pm as this is the time slot allocated by YourTV to TV Bingo.

(e) Cheques for winning players will be delivered before 11:00 pm the night of the show. In the cases of many multiple winners, the courier may not be able to get all cheques delivered that night and will be delivered the next day. The courier will ask for the winning card and will verify the card colour and card number. The player will be asked to sign that they have received the cheque. In the unlikely event the winner has lost or misplaced the winning card, the courier will request that the winner produce identification in order to receive the cheque.
