Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Romans 1:18-20 highlights how God reveals His wrath when He makes Himself known to people who reject Him. How is it fair that God sees people as being without excuse? What excuses do people make for rejecting God?
 2. In Romans 1:21-23 we see how rejecting God leads to wrong thinking. Where do you see people “professing to be wise” when they’ve really become fools?
 3. Romans 1:24-25 shows wrong thinking leading to wrong desire or wrong wanting. When do people exchange the truth of God for a lie? When do people worship the creature rather than the Creator? Why is such behavior foolish?
 4. There’s a clear picture of wrong desire leading to wrong doing in Romans 1:26-27. How have people twisted God’s truth about sexuality? Why do you think the area of sexuality is so closely tied to sin?
 5. Romans 1:28-32 explains how wrong doing leads to contagious deception. Where have you seen the deception of sin spread to others? Where is there pressure to give hearty approval to those practicing things worthy of death? This week, how will you point others to God's truth that opposes deception?
- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
 - Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
 - Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
 - Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
