Life Group Questions to consider:

- 1. The struggle is real. Do you ever find it hard to follow Jesus? When do you find it most difficult? What makes following Jesus easier?
- 2. Romans 7:13-16 explains how the wrongness of sin declares the rightness of God. Do you see your sin as "not that bad" in comparison to others or "utterly sinful" in comparison to God's perfect standard? What's the reality?
- 3. In Romans 7:17-20 we see that our willing doesn't change sin's working. What's at work in you, controlling you? How can our willing become the reality we're doing?
- 4. Romans 7:21-25 shows us how the sin in us is subject to the Spirit in us. How do you manage the conflict of these two natures? How can we, in Christ, experience victory over sin?
- 5. The struggle is real, but God's grace is greater. How are you living in God's grace that's greater than your sin? How will you share that grace this week?
- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
