Life Group Questions to consider:

- 1. Power reveals character. What does God's power reveal about His character? If His Spirit empowers us as His people, how is His character made evident in us?
- 2. Romans 9:1-5 shows us that being like Jesus means the love of God produces a deep love for people and a strong sense of urgency to share the gospel. How does God make us more Christlike? Do you live with intense love and urgent mission?
- 3. Paul explains how God's promises define God's people in Romans 9:6-13. What happens when we base our identity on something other than (less than) God's promises? What defines you?
- 4. In Romans 9:14-18 we see that God's character confirms God's wisdom. What does it mean that His character is trustworthy? Do you trust that He makes the right choices for your life?
- 5. Do you trust God in His sovereignty to accomplish what you cannot? How will you reflect His character and share His wisdom on mission this week?
- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
