Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Sovereignty orders submission. Because we can trust God's power, we should follow His order. What does it look like to order your life under God's sovereignty?
 2. Romans 9:19-24 shows how God's power declares our position. What are "vessels of wrath" and "vessels of mercy"? Why is our humility important?
 3. In Romans 9:25-26, we see God's compassion securing His call on the Gentiles. Why does God choose to save those people who were not His people?
 4. Concerning Israel, Romans 9:27-29 describes God's preservation of a remnant of His people. Why does God choose to preserve a remnant? How is this remnant significant to God's promises?
 5. Romans 9:30-33 explains that God's forgiveness, the righteousness of Christ applied to us, comes only by faith. Why is the idea of works-based righteousness a disappointing stumbling block? How will you share the good news of faith-based forgiveness with someone this week?
- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
 - Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
 - Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
 - Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
