### Ice Breaker

If you could pick any trilogy of movies or books to rewatch or re read from start to finish, which one would it be and why? How does seeing the whole story at once change your perspective compared to just one part?

### Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Prayer for the Lost (Romans 10:1): Paul's heart's desire was for his people to be saved, and he prayed for them faithfully.
  - a. Who is one person God has placed on your heart to pray for?
  - b. How can our group encourage one another to stay faithful in praying for the lost?
2. Objections to Evangelism & Prayer: We often feel unequipped, inadequate, afraid, unburdened, or passive when it comes to sharing our faith.
  - a. Which of these objections resonates most with you right now?
  - b. How do God's Word, Spirit, power, love, and mission answer that specific struggle?
3. Zeal Without Truth (Romans 10:2-4): Paul warns that zeal without knowledge leads to destruction.
  - a. Where do you see examples in our culture of passion or zeal that is not grounded in truth?
  - b. How can discipleship help us and others align zeal with truth?
4. The Simplicity of the Gospel (Romans 10:9-10): Paul says salvation is as near as confessing with your mouth and believing in your heart.
  - a. How does this truth bring both assurance and urgency?
  - b. Have you ever been tempted to make the gospel more complicated than it really is?
5. What It Means to Be Saved: Being saved means more than just forgiveness it brings new identity, transformation, and security in Christ.
  - a. Which of these aspects of salvation encourages you most right now?
  - b. How does reflecting on these truths change the way you see your daily walk with Jesus?
  - c. Support Scriptures: Romans 8:9, John 16:8, John 16:13, Romans 8:15, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Ephesians 2:1-5, Colossians 1:13, Matthew 7:16, Galatians 5:22-23, Ephesians 1:13
6. Everyone Who Calls (Romans 10:11-13): Paul declares that "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
  - a. How does this promise shape the way you see the people around you?
  - b. Who in your life needs to be reminded that this invitation really is for them?
