## Life Group Questions to consider:

Read Romans 11:1-15 and answer the following questions as a group.

- Romans 11:1–2 reminds us that God has not rejected His people. How have you personally seen God's faithfulness in seasons where you doubted or felt distant from Him?
- 2. Paul emphasizes that the remnant is chosen by grace, not works (v. 5–6). How does remembering that salvation is by grace alone shape your daily walk with God and your interactions with others?
- 3. Verses 7–10 describe some whose hearts were hardened. What are some warning signs of a hardening heart in our own lives, and how can we guard against them?
- 4. In verses 11–12, Paul shows how Israel's rejection opened the door for Gentiles to receive salvation. How does this encourage you to trust God's purposes, even when circumstances seem confusing or painful?
- 5. Paul's ministry (v. 13–15) shows a life of faithfulness to God's calling. What practical steps can you take this week to remain faithful by remembering God's compassion, grace, and patience toward you?

## Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to.
  Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
