Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Romans 11:16-21 shows us that God is supreme – how should we live considering His sovereignty? What does it mean to fear Him?
2. In Romans 11:22-24, we see that God is kind, severe, and able – how do these characteristics of God function together? How can we reconcile His patience, His justice, and His power?
3. Romans 11:25-32 describes how God is merciful – what kind of gratitude do we show Him for His mercy? How can we live more thankful lives?
4. Romans 11:33-36 ends the chapter with a declaration of God's unsearchable wisdom – do you trust Him and His wisdom? When are we tempted to trust our circumstances, our senses, or our opinions?
5. His Word secures our hope – where does your hope need to be grounded securely in God's Word? This week, how will you boldly share the hope of Jesus Christ from His Word?

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
