Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Being transformed brings a new norm. What things do we tend to accept as normal that do not align with what Scripture says?
2. Romans 12:1-2 explains that God transforms us to demonstrate His new norm for us. How are we to live differently in light of these verses? How does this different approach to living demonstrate God's new norm for our lives?
3. In Romans 12:3-5, we see how God changes our thinking about ourselves and others. When are you tempted to think more highly of yourself than you ought? What does it mean that we are "one body in Christ, and individually members one of another"?
4. Romans 12:6-8 gives some practical examples of gifts and encourages us to use them with enthusiasm. How has God gifted you? If you don't know your gifts, how do you plan to discover them and use them with enthusiasm?
5. We should live uniquely transformed lives that enthusiastically demonstrate Christ. How is your life demonstrating Christ to the world around you? How are you uniquely positioned to share Jesus with people and influence people toward Him?

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
