Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We all mis-categorize things. Why does God call us to “accept the one who is weak in faith” without “passing judgment on his opinions” like it says in Romans 14:1? How might obeying this command be frustrating to us and our sense of right and wrong?
2. Carefully read through Romans 14:1-12. What does it look like to have rightly prioritized theology? How can we encounter disagreement in Christ without contempt? How should Christ’s sovereignty inform our perspective and our practice? What is the ultimate end to all our disagreements?
3. How does this passage prompt you toward urgency in sharing the gospel? This week, share with someone the good news about being able to stand before God’s judgment with confidence in Jesus Christ.

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
