Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We are all examples in some way. Why would God choose to use flawed humans to represent His kingdom when we condemn and act as “obstacles” and “stumbling blocks” like it says in Romans 14:13? How do you consider your life as an example that others observe?
2. Carefully read through Romans 14:13-23. Why can our preferences sometimes cause destruction in the spiritual growth of others? How should we show the love of Christ in considering others while upholding truth? What does it look like to have a selfless kingdom perspective in the Holy Spirit? How does that apply to the call to faithful action?
3. What will you do in response to this passage? This week, share with someone the good news about the kingdom of God and prioritizing eternity with Christ.

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
