Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Hopefulness often starts with hopelessness. When have you seen hope come from a seemingly hopeless place? Why does God require our awareness of our hopelessness before we can find hope in Him?
2. Carefully read through Romans 15:1-13. What is significant about the command for humility and the prayer for harmony? How do those connect to the concept of hope? Why is it important for our hope to be confirmed in Christ according to the promises of Scripture? What does it mean to “abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit”?
3. What will you do in response to this passage? This week, share with someone the good news about the eternal hope that is confirmed in Christ and abundant in the Spirit.

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
