Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Where are you currently in a season of waiting, and what has that waiting revealed about your trust in God? Consider Simeon and Anna, who waited faithfully for years. How does their example challenge or encourage the way you're waiting right now?
2. The passage shows that God was actively at work while Simeon and Anna waited. How have you seen God sustain or transform you in past seasons of waiting, even when the outcome wasn't clear at the time?
3. Simeon and Anna positioned their lives around God's presence. What does it look like for you, practically, to "resiliently position yourself to be cared for by God" in this season?
4. When God spoke, Simeon responded immediately in obedience. How do you discern when God is speaking, and what can make it difficult to follow when His direction interrupts your expectations or timing?
5. Waiting ultimately led Simeon and Anna to hope fulfilled in Jesus. How does fixing your hope on Christ reshape the way you think about waiting, especially when answers feel delayed or unresolved?

Prayer::

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
