**Life Group Questions to consider:**

1. We train through intentional discipleship. Discipleship is a life-on-life process of following Jesus, becoming like Jesus, and multiplying His life in others. What's challenging about multiplication? Why is discipleship effective? Why is it necessary?
2. Carefully read through Acts 20:17-32 as Paul addresses the elders from the Ephesian church. What does Paul demonstrate about discipleship in this passage? What's important about Paul's proximity to the Ephesians? How does Paul display perseverance in discipleship here? What are the indicators of Paul's passion for discipleship? What does this passage tell us about the legacy that discipleship should leave?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? Your discipleship training challenge is to intentionally move toward multiplying the life of Jesus in others. Whom are you discipling? Who's discipling you? This week, share the gospel of Jesus Christ with someone, and invite someone into a discipleship relationship!

**Prayer:**

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
