**Life Group Questions to consider:**

1. We send on mission to multiply. How is being sent on mission to multiply tied to the idea of discipleship? What does it look like to move from being a passive recipient to being an active participant in God's mission?
2. Carefully read through Acts 3:1-26. What stands out to you as significant? How is God's faithfulness demonstrated? What action is the Holy Spirit prompting in Peter and John? How does God use this passage to redirect perspective? What do Peter and John share as God's intended focus? How does the Holy Spirit through Peter and John challenge the sin of the people present? Why is repentance fundamental to God's forgiveness?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? How will you actively participate in God's mission? How will you follow the Holy Spirit's prompting toward action to share the gospel of Jesus Christ that brings repentance and true healing?

**Prayer:**

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
