Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We send on mission to multiply. What happens when the mission encounters opposition? How does someone stand for truth when it's difficult or unpopular? How can someone avoid fearfully following the crowd? Why is the Holy Spirit vital to the mission in the face of opposition?
2. Carefully read through Acts 4:1-37. Why are the Sadducees opposing Peter and John? How does the Holy Spirit work to produce confidence here? What does the Council command, and how do Peter and John respond? Is their response arrogant? What is it about the authority of the Holy Spirit that inspires courage? What's the result of that courage? What do you notice about the prayer of the disciples? How does the Holy Spirit become contagious afterward? What's the outcome of the Spirit spreading? What does the resulting community look like?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? Is the Holy Spirit evident in your life? How so? This week, walk in His confidence, speak in His courage, and let Him be contagious through you as you share the gospel and invite people into His community!

Prayer:

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
