**Life Group Questions to consider:**

1. We send on mission to multiply. The book of Acts shows the church acting on mission with a focus on the Holy Spirit as central. What do people tend to put at their center? How can people shift from self-centeredness to Spirit-centeredness?
2. Carefully read through Acts 8:1-40. What is significant about the Spirit's power during persecution? Why is preaching the good news of the gospel connected to rejoicing? How does the Holy Spirit bring conviction and correction? What's the difference between conviction and correction? How does the Holy Spirit guide both Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch in both truth and obedience? How does this passage show the Spirit maintaining His mission for the church?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? Is your life centered on the Holy Spirit? Are you experiencing His power, boldness, joy, conviction, and correction? How will you follow Him in truth and obedience on mission to share the gospel this week?

**Prayer:**

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
