Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We send on mission to multiply. The book of Acts describes change brought on by the Holy Spirit. How does the Holy Spirit change our focus? What changes would happen if we focused on Jesus?
2. Carefully read through Acts 9:1-43. What stands out most about Saul's conversion experience? What change happens in Saul immediately following his conversion? What changes happen in the Jews and in the disciples? How does proclaiming Jesus reflect people's priorities here? What is significant about the roles of Ananias and Barnabas? Why is church growth tied to both the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit? Why does this passage include mention of miracles performed by Peter?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? Has your life been changed by encountering Jesus? Is proclaiming Jesus your priority? This week, specifically prioritize proclaiming Jesus to someone!

Prayer:

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
