Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We send on mission to multiply. The book of Acts describes how the gospel spreads beyond limitations. How could current categories limit the spread of the gospel? How does the Holy Spirit challenge existing categories?
2. Carefully read through Acts 10:1-48. What is significant about Cornelius receiving a vision? What is distinct about the vision Peter receives? Why does the passage mention both Cornelius and Peter praying? How does God's cleansing exceed categories here? What's unexpected about how God directs Peter? Why does Peter obey without understanding what's happening? What does it mean that God is not one to show partiality? How does the presence of the Holy Spirit confirm the reach of the gospel?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? This week, follow Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit, and tell someone how He can make them clean by faith alone!

Prayer:

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
- Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
