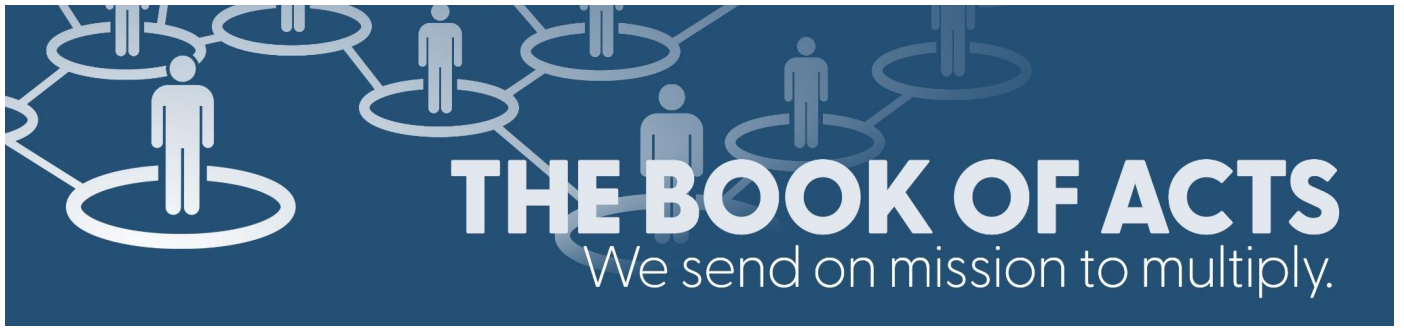

Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Where are you struggling to trust that Jesus is keeping His promises? Stephen never saw Antioch, but Christ did. Is there an area of your life where you're having a hard time seeing what God is doing?
2. What ordinary place has God placed you in to speak about Jesus? The gospel spread because ordinary believers simply talked about Jesus. Who has God placed in your life right now that He is calling you to engage and share Jesus with?
3. What burden are you carrying that actually belongs to Christ? John Piper says faithfulness belongs to us, but fruitfulness belongs to God. Are you carrying responsibility for something only Jesus can do? What would it look like to let go and trust God?
4. Where have you seen the fingerprints of God's grace recently? In what ways have you seen the evidence of God's grace at work in your life and relationships in the past 3 months?
5. If someone had to give you a nickname based on how you live, what would it be? The people of Antioch created a new word and category for those who followed Christ. What would people say about you based on how they see you live and interact with others?

Prayer:

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
