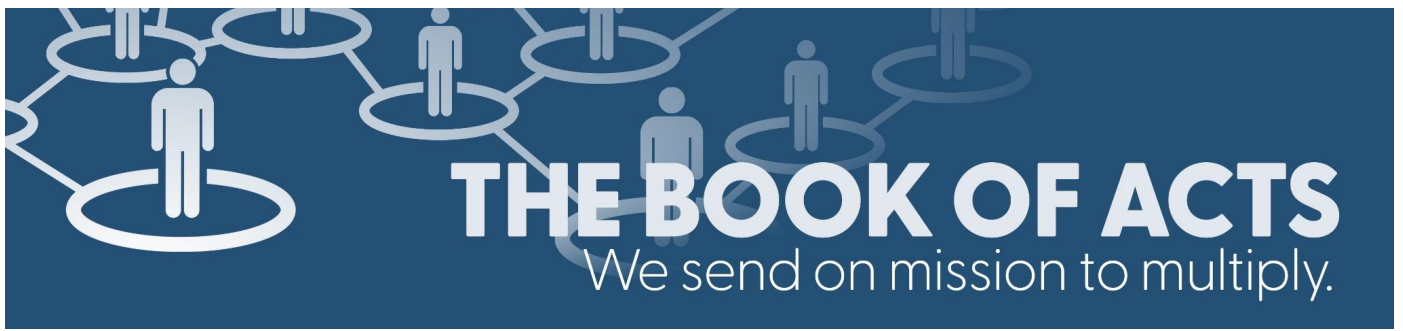

Life Group Questions to consider:

1. We send on mission to multiply. The book of Acts is about how the Holy Spirit brings new life to His people for His mission. Where do you find yourself falling into old patterns of comfort instead of new life in the Spirit? How is God calling you beyond comfort?
2. Carefully read through Acts 21:1-40. What do the cities mentioned demonstrate about the spread of the gospel? What is challenging about the words of the disciples and Agabus? Why does Paul insist on going to Jerusalem despite the warnings of danger? How did Paul's reputation get misrepresented among the Jews in Jerusalem? Why did Paul agree to participate in the customary Jewish purification? Why did the people react so strongly against Paul? What is significant about Paul's wisdom and words near the end of this passage?
3. How will you respond to this passage of Scripture? How will you follow the calling of God on your life? Where does your faith need to grow in firmness and/or flexibility? This week, who will hear the Holy Spirit speak through you?

Prayer:

- For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.
- Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.
- Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
