Read Isaiah 7:14

1

Read Isaiah 9:6-7

Play Christmas music and have a dance party (or look up Christmas music videos to dance along to!)

2

Read John 3:16-17

Leave a kind note in public for someone to find (leave it in the grocery store, library, school or park!)

3

Read Luke 1:26-28

Take silly Christmas family pictures (ugly Christmas sweaters are always a good idea!)

4

Read Luke 1:29-31

Make Christmas cards for someone who serves your family or neighborhood (like your mail carrier, trash collector or teacher!)

5

Read Luke 1:32-33

Drive (or take a walk) and look at neighborhood Christmas lights

6

Read Luke 1:34-36

Write down three people's names, stick them somewhere you'll see, and pray for them each day this week

7

Read Luke 1:39-40

When Jesus was born, he brought true lasting peace! Make a list of worries or fears—then pray and ask Jesus to help you have peace instead!

8

Read Luke 1:41-45

Decorate Christmas cookies and give them away (No time for cookies? Cook popcorn, or make some Trailmix!)

9

Read Luke 1:46-56

Gather some clothes or toys to donate to a charity or thrift store

10

Read Matthew 1:18-25

Grab some markers and paper and make a birthday card for Jesus

11

Read Luke 2:1-5

Make paper snowflakes and stick them on your windows

12

Read Luke 2:6-7

Take stickers to the grocery store and offer strangers

13

Read John 1:14

Make hot cocoa (extra points if you hand out hot cocoa to friends or strangers!)

14

Read Luke 2:8-9

Christmas gives us JOY! So get silly and do some Christmas madlibs (find a madlib form at crossroadskidsclub.net/Christmas)

Read Luke 2:10-14

Do a secret act of kindness for someone

Read about the wise men in Matthew 2:7-11, then go outside in the dark and look up at the stars

Read Luke 2:15-17

Read Luke 2:19-20

Make a nativity scene out of playdough (No playdough? Draw a picture instead)

Call someone you love just to say hello

Read Matthew 2:1-12

Read Luke 2:1-20 as a family. Play charades to act out different people, places or things from the Christmas story—no talking!

Make a list of 10 things you're thankful for, then pray and thank God for them
