ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! Whose word is true? God's Word is true."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, let the things You say in Your Word, the Bible, remind us how much You love us and others."



Drive Time

While on the go, talk about different words and how important they are. Say: "God's Words are the most important of all."



Bath Time

As you give your child a bath, ask them: "If you could teach your bath tub toys one thing, what would you teach them?" Tell them Jesus taught in the temple when He was young.
