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ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them: “God wants a real relationship with you. He speaks, and you can learn to recognize His voice.”



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone answer this question: “How can you hear from God?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “What are some distractions that make it hard to hear from God?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “Dear God, in a noisy world, help us slow down and listen for Your voice. Teach us to hear You through Your Word, in our hearts, through others, and through what You’ve made.”
