



No Surprise Act

Protects against surprise billing from non-emergency services provided by out-of-network providers at in-network ambulatory surgical centers. This means that if a patient receives care at an in-network ASC from a provider who is not in their insurance network the patient is generally protected from being balance billed (charged more than their in-network cost sharing amount).

What is Surprise Billing?

Surprise billing happens when a patient receives an unexpected bill after receiving care at an in-network facility like hospitals, hospital outpatient departments and ambulatory surgery centers.
