General Information and Instructions

- Prior to your procedure, you will be contacted by one of our Pre-Operative nurses to review your medical history and medications.
- If you need interpretation services, please inform the nurse and we will provide them for you.

Night Before and Morning of Surgery

For Infection Prevention:

- Please shower or bathe with mild, fragrance free soap and shampoo (no alcohol-based products).
- Clean hair thoroughly no hair products (gels, sprays, etc.) after washing.
- Use a clean towel and wear freshly laundered clothes.
- Change bed linens, if possible, before surgery.
- No makeup, nail polish, perfumes, lotions or deodorant on the day of surgery

Eating & Drinking Guidelines:

- No solid food or milk after midnight.
- No gum, candy, mints or tobacco on the day of your surgery.

Medication Instructions:

Medications to Continue the Morning of Surgery:

- Take morning medications with a sip of water, except for diabetic medications and diuretics.
- Please take blood pressure medications (excluding ACE inhibitors), anxiety, pain, reflux, seizure, vertigo (if needed, please take).
- **USE** daily inhalers or breathing treatments.
- DO NOT take vitamins and/or natural supplements – these must be stopped 7 days prior to surgery.

Anticoagulants/Antiplatelets (Blood Thinners):

 Please consult with your Cardiologist/Prescribing Physician for instructions on when to hold your medication.

Diabetic Medications:

- Insulin: If you are on an insulin pump, please leave it on and decrease the dose by 50% after midnight the night before surgery.
- **DO NOT** take any insulin or oral diabetic medications in the morning.
- Take ½ of your bedtime insulin dosage the night before surgery with a high protein snack.
- **Metformin:** Please hold for 1 day prior to surgery.
- If your A.M. blood sugar is <70, >350 or symptomatic – please call the center for instructions: 330-892-5353.

GLP-1s – Injectable (Zepbound, Ozempic, Mounjaro):

 Must stop 1 week prior to surgery, follow a full liquid diet 24 hours prior to surgery, and nothing by mouth after midnight.

GLP1s - Oral (Rybelsus):

 Must hold 1 day prior to surgery, follow a full liquid diet 24 hours prior to surgery, and nothing by mouth after midnight.

SGLT2-inhibitors (Jardiance, Farxiga, Syngardy):

• Must hold 3 days prior to surgery.



Arrival Instructions:

- The Pre-Operative nurse will contact you 1-2 days prior to your surgery to inform you of your arrival time.
- Please bring a photo ID, insurance card, your copay (if applicable) and a list of your medications with you on the day of surgery.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothes; no jewelry, makeup or contact lenses.
- Please bring any mobility devices (crutches/walker/cane) or braces with you on the day of surgery.
