Poster Program Guidelines –

The CEATI T&D Conference Poster Program provides an opportunity for participants to showcase and discuss innovative work, emerging ideas, and recent developments with industry peers in an interactive and highly visual format.

Poster presentations are intended to encourage technical exchange, practical discussion, and networking among conference attendees. Posters will be displayed during the conference, with dedicated poster session(s) where authors can engage directly with participants, answer questions, and discuss their work in detail.

Participation and Submission Information

Those interested in participating are asked to [complete the submission form](#) by **Thursday, September 10th** and provide:

- Name and contact information
- Affiliated organization (utility, university, vendor, etc.)
- A 300-word summary of the proposed poster presentation

The deadline for submission of ready-to-present posters is **Thursday, October 15**. Please submit to tdconference@ceati.com.

Please note that presenters are responsible for printing and bringing their own posters to the conference.

As this is the inaugural year of the CEATI T&D Conference Poster Initiative:

- Students and CEATI utility members whose posters are accepted will receive a complimentary 2-day conference pass to attend the poster session and conference activities.
- Vendors wishing to participate are asked to purchase or apply a complimentary exhibitor registration in order to participate in the conference and poster session at no additional poster program cost.

Suggested Topics

The program welcomes contributions that highlight current challenges, lessons learned, research findings, operational experience, or new approaches relevant to the continuously evolving transmission and distribution sector.

Examples of suitable poster topics include, but are not limited to:

- Emerging technologies, tools, or methodologies
- Pilot projects, demonstrations, or field trials
- Operational experiences and case studies
- Innovative applications of existing technologies or datasets
- Work-in-progress or early-stage initiatives
- Practical solutions to industry challenges
- Grid modernization, reliability, resiliency, and asset management initiatives
- Applications of data analytics, AI, digitalization, or visualization in T&D environments
- Sustainability, electrification, DER integration, or energy transition projects
- Highlights of recently completed or previously presented work relevant to the CEATI community

Posters should emphasize clear communication, visual engagement, and practical insights that encourage discussion and knowledge sharing among conference participants.

There are two broad audiences for these posters: Firstly, the CEATI T&D conference attendees which is traditionally made up of mid-to-senior global T&D utility staff and OEMs. Secondly, because the CEATI technical Interest Group meetings are collocated with the annual T&D conference, the audience includes utility representatives to CEATI Interest Groups.
