

Foundations of Leadership | Week One

Moses is considered Israel's greatest leader and prophet. His life and leadership are worthy of careful reflection. As we will learn, there are parallel aspects between the lives of Moses and Jesus. For the next 4 weeks we will move slowly through the life of Moses. Read reflectively and prayerfully, watching for glimpses of Jesus along the way.

DATE: *June 1*

VERSE: *Exodus 1:15-2:10*

REFLECTION: God used five women to defy the enemy to bring about His purpose by protecting Moses' life. Looking back, who has God used in your life to bring about His purpose?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, help me trust Your hand in seasons that feel hidden, specifically . . .

DATE: *June 2*

VERSE: *Exodus 2:11-25*

REFLECTION: When has fear caused you to run and how did God find you there?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, thank You for pursuing me and providing for me in every wilderness. In fear I run toward . . .

DATE: *June 3*

VERSE: *Exodus 3:1-15*

REFLECTION: God answers Moses' question in verse 11 with His Presence (I'll be with you) and a purpose (I'm sending you). How do those 2 things speak to your own identity?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, ground my identity in who You are and what You've given me to do . . .

DATE: *June 4*

VERSE: *Exodus 3:16-4:17*

REFLECTION: What is in your "hand" (skills, talents, education, wiring) you sense the Lord is wanting to use for His purpose?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, meet me in my insecurity and help me surrender all of me for Your purpose . . .

DATE: *June 5*

VERSE: *Exodus 4:18-31*

REFLECTION: What does this passage teach you about leadership and dependence?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, teach me to rely fully on You in all I do and in who I am . . .

DATE: *June 8*

VERSE: *Exodus 5:1-21*

REFLECTION: What is your default response when things get harder after following God?

PRAYER PROMPT: Lord, form perseverance in me when obedience feels costly . . .

DATE: *June 9*

VERSE: *Exodus 5:22-6:13*

REFLECTION: Look again at 6:6-8 at all the Lord has promised to do. What promises has God made in His Word that you need to remind yourself of today?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, You are a Promise Keeper. Help me remember You are . . .

DATE: *June 10*

VERSE: *Exodus 7:1-13*

REFLECTION: In what ways is God inviting you to partner with Him to do what seems impossible?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, ground me in Your authority and give me the courage to be obedient with what you ask . . .

DATE: *June 11*

VERSE: *Exodus 11:1-10*

REFLECTION: What does this moment reveal about God's justice and timing? How do you respond when justice feels delayed?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, help me trust Your timing and Your ways, even when I can't trace Your hand . . .

DATE: *June 12*

VERSE: *Exodus 32:7-14*

REFLECTION: Who is God inviting you to intercede for?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, give me a heart that contends for others . . .

DATE: *June 15*

VERSE: *Exodus 19:1-9*

REFLECTION: How does Moses continually position himself to hear God? What rhythms help you listen well?

PRAYER PROMPT: Speak, Lord. Help me cultivate a life that listens to the sound of Your voice above all others . . .

DATE: *June 16*

VERSE: *Exodus 33:12-23*

REFLECTION: Where and when are you tempted to choose performance or results over His presence?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, if You don't go with me, I don't want to go. Anchor me in Your presence . . .

DATE: *June 17*

VERSE: *Exodus 18:13-27*

REFLECTION: Jethro says, "The work is too heavy for you; you cannot handle it alone." Where do you need to release control and share leadership?

PRAYER PROMPT: Lord, give me wisdom to ask for help, to lead with others, not alone . . .

DATE: *June 18*

VERSE: *Numbers 20:1-13*

REFLECTION: Moses learns the cost of partial obedience. Is there an area of your life where you are offering only partial obedience to the Lord?

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, form in me a fully obedient heart. Forgive my partial obedience in . . .

DATE: *June 19*

VERSE: *Exodus 16:1-18*

REFLECTION: Where do you struggle to depend on God day by day, moment by moment?

PRAYER PROMPT: Give us this day our daily bread - physically and spiritually . . . help me to trust You with . . .

DATE: *June 22*

VERSE: *Numbers 27:12-23*

REFLECTION: Who are you investing in, training, mentoring? How are you preparing others to lead?

PRAYER PROMPT: Lord, help me invest in others and release leadership with grace . . .

DATE: *June 23*

VERSE: *Deuteronomy 34:1-12*

REFLECTION: What stands out to you in this passage? How do you want to finish your race?

PRAYER PROMPT: Lord, help me live with the end in mind - faithful to the finish . . .

DATE: *June 24*

VERSE: *Joshua 1:1-9*

REFLECTION: What imperatives are given in verse 8-9? Write them down.

PRAYER PROMPT: Father, let my life be marked by love for Your Word, obedience and Your presence. Help me to . . .

DATE: *June 25*

VERSE: *Hebrews 11:23-29*

REFLECTION: If Hebrews 11 had a verse 41, what would it say? "By faith (insert your name) . . .

PRAYER PROMPT: Holy Spirit, shape my life by faith to . . .

DATE: *June 26*

VERSE: *Luke 9:28-36*

REFLECTION: Moses and Elijah are speaking with Jesus about His "departure" (exodos in Greek). Can you imagine that conversation? Jesus fulfilled what Moses and Israel could not. Can you trust Him today with what is unfulfilled in your life?

PRAYER PROMPT: Jesus, You are the fulfillment of the Promise. Help me trust You not only with my legacy but my life and death as well . . .
