PROGRESS REPORTS

Fruitville Campus Renovation:

- Our Fruitville campus is in desperate need to expand their space and we are currently working on renovating the parking lot at their campus as well as expanding the foyer space to accommodate the growth they are seeing.



Spanish Campus:

- It is our heart to fund and launch a Spanish campus this year!

Fully Fund the North River Campus Expansion Project:

- Progress is already taking place on the North River expansion project. Thanks to the generosity of Kingdom Builders, we are now within reach of fully funding this project. A

small remaining gap still exists, and we are believing that God will provide the final resources needed to complete the expansion debt-free.





Fund a New Campus Launch:

- Our goal is to fund the launch of a new campus in 2027. We are still praying and seeking God about where this new campus launch will be, but plan to be financially ready to move when God leads us to where our next campus should launch.

NEXT GEN:

- We are working on a method in the AI space for Spanish translation of our Sunday services, for the upcoming Spanish campus launch.

XII Conference 2026:

- This year's XII Conference will focus on Matthew 6:10: "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." Students will learn that they are part of God's Kingdom and called to bring heaven to earth. We're praying for continued growth to reach 5,000 students as well as for powerful life change across this generation.



Bayside College

Bayside College Residency Program:

- The Bayside College Residency Program is a 9-month paid ministry development experience designed for exceptional recent Bayside College graduates. Residents serve as Coordinators at a Bayside campus, gaining hands-on ministry experience, leadership training, mentorship, and real-world job skills. The program provides an inside look at church leadership while preparing participants for future ministry and professional opportunities. Upon completion, residents are positioned as strong candidates for open staff roles at Bayside.

Enrollment & Academic Progress:

- Bayside College continues to experience steady growth and expanding impact across all academic programs.
- This year, 221 students are being trained and disciplined through Bayside College — 139 undergraduates and 82 Young Leader Experience (Y LX) students.

Bayside College Progress Report:

- **Our dorms are opening this fall.** – This fall marks an exciting milestone for Bayside College as we open student housing on campus for the very first time. Seven residence halls will be available for students, along with our new Resident Director unit. These new units will provide students with a vibrant, Christ-centered community right on campus.
- **New academic pathways** – In Spring 2027 we're launching a Franchise Accreditation course and a Bayside Leadership Institute class, giving students additional credit hours and marketplace-ready credentials.
- **International Student Acceptance** – We have submitted everything to Homeland Security for us to begin accepting international students, waiting on the approval from them.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Kids, Youth & XII Conference:

There are always amazing discipleship opportunities being a small group leader within Bayside Kids or Youth services. Kids and middle school services happen every Sunday, while High school services happen every Wednesday.

Additionally, there is an incredible opportunity to impact the lives of students by serving as a chaperone at XII Conference. Every year, students' lives are changed through the messages they hear, the relationships they build, and the moments they experience with God. Sometimes it is a conversation on a bus ride, a discussion in a small group, or a connection with a caring youth leader or peer that makes all the difference. Other times, it is a powerful encounter with God that marks the beginning of a lifelong journey of faith and discipleship. XII Conference creates space for students to step away from the distractions of everyday life and focus on what matters most. It is a place where hearts are transformed, identities are shaped, and faith takes root. As a chaperone, you have the opportunity to be part of those life-changing moments. Your presence, encouragement, and investment can have an eternal impact on a student's life, helping create an environment where students can encounter God and take their next step in following Him.

Bayside College:

One of the most powerful ways to invest in the next generation of ministry and marketplace leaders is through our **Marketplace Practicum**. This year, 13 local business leaders and Bayside attendees joined us for a meet-and-greet that opened doors to mentorship and internships, and guest speakers poured into our students on what it means to carry a Christian worldview into business.

There's room for you in this. Whether you mentor a student, host an intern, or share your expertise as a guest speaker, your investment can shape how a young leader carries their faith into the workplace for life. If God has given you a seat at a table, you can help a student find theirs.

YTH CAMP:

Youth Camp was a truly impactful experience, and we saw God move in powerful ways in the lives of many students. Throughout the weekend, students engaged with key messages centered on their heart, their soul, and their identity. As they leaned into these truths, many found freedom in Jesus and experienced significant spiritual breakthroughs. Students courageously worked through struggles they had been carrying and took meaningful steps toward healing, growth, and transformation.

Beyond the sessions, students built deeper connections with their peers through their groups and strengthened relationships with their youth leaders. These conversations and shared experiences created an environment where students felt seen, supported, and encouraged in their faith. It was an incredible weekend, and the spiritual momentum we're seeing in our high school ministry right now is both inspiring and encouraging. The spiritual water table is rising, and we're excited to see how God continues to work in the lives of these students.

KIDS CAMP:

This year at Kids Camp, we launched into an unforgettable adventure called **The Big Launch**, where kids discovered the incredible truth that **We Are God's Masterpiece!** Through an exciting space-themed experience, campers explored the story of creation and learned that God intentionally created every part of His world. They discovered that people are the most special part of God's creation because we are made in His image. Throughout the week, kids journeyed through the seven days of creation, learning how God created the world with purpose, creativity, and care. They explored what it means to be made in the image of God and discovered the truth of **Ephesians 2:10**, that we are God's masterpiece, created by Him and for Him. Most importantly, kids learned that their worth is not found in what they do, what they have, or what others think about them. Their value comes from the God who created them. They were reminded that they are loved, chosen, and created on purpose for a purpose. This year, we continued offering Kids Camp at four locations across our region, making it possible for even more families to participate. With more than **2,044 children registered** and **763 volunteers**, it was our largest Kids Camp to date. Our prayer is that every child left camp knowing they are made in the image of God, deeply loved by their Creator, and truly His masterpiece.

Bayside College Enrollment & Academic Progress - Bayside College continues to experience steady growth and expanding impact across all academic programs.

- **2026 Graduating Class:** 19 Bachelor Degrees, 5 Associate Degrees, 6 Certificates, and 1 Masters Degree.
- **Since 2015:** Bayside College has now conferred 240 Bachelor's, 67 Associate's, 20 Master's, and 11 Certificate credentials, building on the 290+ alumni who have gone before.
- **Dual Enrollment / YLX:** 82 students
- **YLX to Undergraduate pipeline:** 13 of our 30 Spring 2026 Dual Enrollment graduates continued into our undergraduate program.
- **Housing:** 44 students lived on campus through ResLife, made possible in part by Kingdom Builders giving.
- **Kingdom Builders Scholarships:** 28 students received a Kingdom Builders Scholarship for 2025–26, including a Larry Stockstill Full-Ride Scholarship.

Bayside College Story Wins:

We're celebrating the professional placement of **Gracie Lapointe** at SmartPro and **Josh Ivey** as Kids Director at the Fruitville Bayside campus. Graduates **Grace McCullough** and **Micah Smith** are entering the Bayside College Residency Program this fall. Six of our students — **Alisha Parshad, Ryan Johnson, Lily Lindskog, Kirsten Benigni, Connor Scott, and Abby Wead** — are serving as ARC Europe interns, carrying the gospel across the world.

Maybe the best way to capture it is in a student's own words. **Gabriella Buccellato** shares:

"Bayside College provided many great opportunities to learn how to live in the real world while actively keeping your faith. Through the Marketplace Practicum, I learned how to reflect my faith in jobs outside the church walls, and I feel more confident now showing my Christian values in places where it may seem difficult to. This year I interned as an assistant to Jessica Gilliard and Madison Harrison, and I gained real professional knowledge — attending meetings, handling spreadsheets — along with a deeper relationship with the staff. It was less of a student-teacher relationship and more one formed on teamwork. I'm so thankful for these opportunities that have paved the way for how I'll carry myself in secular workplaces."

Next-Gen Mission Trips:

To date, we have invested \$11,040 toward next-gen mission trip scholarships, supporting 12 students in serving through missions opportunities.

The remainder of our youth and family mission trips will take place throughout June and July. These upcoming trips represent an additional investment of \$181,579, providing mission trip scholarships for 110 participants across both youth and family trips.

- **Year-to-Date & Upcoming Total:**
\$192,619 invested in mission trips, impacting 122 participants.

PROGRESS REPORTS

Community Update

- **North River Parking:** The main parking lot is paved and fully operational! Lighting and striping are expected to wrap up in July, and construction on the additional exit is on track for mid-fall.
- **North River Auditorium Expansion:** The sound booth relocation is officially complete. Construction on the main expansion is underway and we are on target for a year-end completion to help facilitate campus growth.
- **North River Kids Building:** Following some initial planning delays, we are currently awaiting final site plan approval and building permit. The updated completion timeline is now early 2027 as we work toward full funding for this project.
- **Fruitville Parking Lot Expansion:** We are continuing to work closely with our design team and the City of Sarasota to navigate unexpected complexities and evaluate our best options moving forward.
- **Fruitville Lobby & Office Move:** Preliminary design work is complete, and the project is currently out for bidding. We are also actively waiting on full funding to launch into the next phase.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Bradenton Dream Center

- **Current Status:** The structural rollout for both our seasonal and year-round student tracks has met its core implementation benchmarks for the first half of the year.
- **Breakthroughs:** Successfully bridged the gap between our academic-year programming and summer camp tracks, creating a seamless environment of support for our students.
- **Transparency/Challenges:** Navigating high engagement means our resource demands (specifically meal logistics, staffing/volunteer recruitment and retention) remain at an all-time high.
- **Upcoming Opportunities:** We are actively opening up service opportunities for the upcoming fall semester launch. We will need academic mentors, small group leaders, and meal distribution teams to sustain our current momentum.

WINS+ IMPACT STORIES

Bradenton Dream Center

Our community programming has seen incredible momentum across both the academic year and our summer camp. Below is the direct data tracking our reach, engagement, and physical care provided to the next generation:

Impact Highlight: By serving **106 unique students** across **80 unique families**, we are ensuring that the baseline needs of our local community's households are covered. Providing over **12,000 meals** means we aren't just occupying kids after school—we are actively fueling them to grow, learn, and thrive.

Food & Nutritional Care

- **Daily Provision:** Every student enrolled received consistent access to healthy, nutritious meals and snacks during programming.
- **Impact Volume:** A combined total of **12,024 meals and snacks** were served to fuel student focus, physical health, and active participation.
- **Fresh Groceries:** Families were supported beyond daily program hours with targeted grocery distributions, including high-demand items like **fresh meat**.

Transportation & Logistical Security

- **Pipeline School Pick-Up:** Reliable, secure transit was provided directly from core partner schools, specifically **Ballard Elementary School** and **G.D. Rogers Garden Elementary**.

- **Authorized Release Network:** Strict student pick-up and transportation consent protocols were managed to eliminate travel barriers for **80 unique working families** while ensuring total student safety.

Academic & Digital Support

- **Targeted Learning Interventions:** Students received tailored, individual attention to support school progress, focusing on core **Reading and English Language Arts (ELA)** proficiency, math growth, and specialized **ESOL** support for bilingual households.
- **IEP Alignment:** On-site assistance was coordinated to align with students' specific school IEP (Individualized Education Program) goals.
- **Supervised Digital Literacy:** Monitored access to technology and educational software was offered under an intentional Internet Use and Safety Policy to assist with homework and digital learning skills.
- **STEAM Enrichment:** Summer camp students participated in hands-on experiential learning field trips focused specifically on **STEAM** (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) concepts.

Social-Emotional, Spiritual, & Family Support

- **Crisis & Mental Health Care:** Direct access to professional counseling services was provided for students and families requiring specialized mental health or emotional support.
- **Behavioral Mentorship:** Structural accountability goals were implemented to help students refrain from negative behavior referrals both at school and within the program environment.
- **Parent Giveaways & Seasonal Gifts:** Households were blessed throughout the year with essential **clothing giveaways** and various targeted seasonal gifts centered around major calendar milestones, including **Valentine's Day, Spring Break, and the End of the School Year**.
- **Bayside Kids Camp Collaboration:** Campers were integrated into a vibrant peer environment through a direct partnership with **Bayside Kids Camp**, fostering healthy social connections and community belonging.
- **Character & Faith Development:** Daily programming was anchored in character building, guiding students toward personal accountability, mutual respect, and opportunities to profess and grow in their faith in Christ.

Impact Highlight: 10 Months, 10 Verses...

Nearly 100 students across 5 teams spent the last year building a life-changing spiritual habit: **memorizing the exact same scripture verse every single month for 10 months.**

Your investment didn't just buy charts and stickers—it funded a structural discipline that yielded incredible results:

- **Consistent Dedication: 36 students** successfully mastered **5 or more months** of scriptures.
- **Leading the Pack: Team 1 (Kindergarten-1st grade)** crushed the benchmark, with **70% of the class** memorizing 5+ months of verses.
- **Perfect Streaks: 2 students** (Charlee (KG) and Landon (KG)) hit a perfect **10-month streak**, memorizing every single verse!

- **Team Strength & Protection:** Spiritual and physical endurance for our staff and volunteers who are on the front lines of student ministry day in and day out.
- **Family Impact:** That the deep connection built with these 80 families opens consistent doors for deeper spiritual conversations, salvations, and community breakthroughs.
- **School Partnerships:** That as the district moves around different principals/leadership, we will continue to find favor and ways to make an impact within our community.
