- Support First Nations and Metis communities to design and implement a gang prevention program.
- Provide ongoing training and mentorship to the communities on the issues of Indigenous gangs.
- Structure training on Indigenous gangs and provide research information on Indigenous gangs.

Our ideal candidate would have the following qualifications:

- **In-depth experience and working knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultures, healing and language.**
- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people and extensive knowledge of Indigenous cultures, languages and organizations within the area.
- Extensive knowledge of Government organizations and operations at all levels of government.
- Experience in working in justice and/or corrections with extensive knowledge and experience of contracts and negotiations.
- Good working knowledge of computers and information technology.
- Ability to develop relationships and work within the community with organizations and individuals, with excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Up to date criminal record check, child intervention checks upon hire.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta drivers license and required liability insurance to use your vehicle as part of your employment.
